ENDORSEMENT SEALS THE DEAL

In a recent survey of Florida Republican primary voters (RPV) (see methodology statement on last page), Fabrizio, Lee & Associates found Byron Donalds is the clear frontrunner in the 2026 Florida Governor Republican primary race driven by the endorsement of President Trump. In all ballot variations, Donalds leads the field by double digits, especially over current declared and potential candidates. Donalds wins more than two-thirds of those who know President Donald Trump endorsed him for governor. Lastly, any sugar high from Jay Collins' multimillion ad buy has completely dissipated. Virtually no RPVs recall seeing anything about Collins (only 16%) and Donalds crushes him in every ballot permutation.

Byron Donalds Wins Every Ballot Variation, Up Huge with those Aware of POTUS Endorsement

Regardless of what the ballot is, Byron Donalds is the clear leader among Republican primary voters to unify the GOP and keep Florida red. Donalds leads Florida First Lady Casey DeSantis 39%-26% (+13) on a four-way Republican primary ballot. Among the 44% of RPV who are aware of President Trump endorsing Byron, DeSantis trails 68%-10% (+58). Jay Collins trails Donalds considerably more than DeSantis, and Donalds leads Collins 45%-6% (+39) on a four-way primary ballot, leading 73%-5% (+68) with those aware of President Trump endorsing Donalds. Lastly on a three-way ballot, Donalds (47%) leads James Fishback (5%) and Paul Renner (4%) by +42 and +43 respectively. Again, among voters aware of President Trump's endorsement, Donalds (76%) majorly leads Fishback (6%) and Renner (1%).

Trump's Endorsement Beats DeSantis' Endorsement: Informing Voters About President Donald Trump's Endorsement Greatly Increases Byron Donalds' Lead, Even Against DeSantis-Endorsed Candidate

Informing voters of President Trump's endorsement of Donalds increases Donalds' lead on each ballot iteration. In the informed ballot with a Ron DeSantis-endorsed Casey DeSantis, the Trump endorsement widens the race from Donalds leading DeSantis 39%-26% (+13) to Donalds leading DeSantis 48%-21% (+27). Donalds increases his lead over Jay Collins from 45%-6% (+39) to 58%-4% (+54) on the informed Presidential endorsement ballot. If Collins were to receive Governor DeSantis' endorsement, Donalds still crushes him 50%-10% (+40). Lastly, Donalds also gains in the three-way ballot going from Donalds 47%, Fishback 5%, and Renner 4% to Donalds 61% (shifting +14), Fishback 5%, and Renner 3% (shifting -1). Despite Casey DeSantis' last name and Jay Collins' multimillion ad spend, Byron Donalds is far and away the clear choice to unify Florida Republicans, keep the state red, and defeat the Democrats in November.

METHODOLOGY STATEMENT: Fabrizio, Lee & Associates conducted a statewide survey of 600 likely Florida Republican primary voters from January 4-6, 2026. The interviews were split 40% live-operator cell phone/15% live-operator landline/45% SMS to web. Gender, age, race/ethnicity, and education were matched to demographic profiles of likely Republican primary voters based on the voter file and exit polls. Respondents were randomly selected from lists of registered Republican voters who either voted in at least 1 of the past 4 Republican primaries or have registered to vote since the last primary. The margin of sampling error at the 95% confidence interval is $\pm 4.0\%$.
