Yesterday morning I could not work on any of my books because the Spirit of God kept telling me to write things in blog posts.

One post was an answer to two questions I had received on keys. The other three posts were about calamities and sacrifice; three warnings of current and future disaster; how God will shake all things not of him to show us the consequences of things as they really are; how God's many many warnings to people have gone mostly unheeded, and how people will receive what they have chosen.

Less than an hour later, the largest earthquake

in decades hit Utah, epicenter close to Salt Lake City, and knocked the trumpet out of the angel Moroni statue on the Salt Lake Temple.

The Lord woke me up at 2am this morning. "...He wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned." (Isaiah 50:4)

He said the time is short for those on the I-15 corridor.

I have spent who knows how much time and how many prayers trying to help who knows how many people be persuaded that staying in cities and suburbs in general, and in the I-15 corridor specifically, will lead to severe suffering and in many cases death. I know of very few who have listened.

Behold, they do not desire that the Lord their God, who hath created them, should rule and reign over them; notwithstanding his great goodness and his mercy towards them, they do set at naught his counsels, and they will not that he should be their guide. (Helaman 12:6)

These warnings have been coming since at least 2014. You will find many posts here on the topic. I've talked to many of you face to face about it.

- I've covered what is going to happen.
- I've covered why it is going to happen.
- I've covered where you should go.
- I've covered when you should go.

*(Note: Do not email me asking me any of these questions--I've already answered them, and given the time it takes to obtain these things and write them, the least you can do is search them. Most if not all are **tagged**).*

If you had listened before, you would have had time to comfortably sell your house for a good price, carefully select a place to go, secure a new job before moving, and enjoy the road trip. Utah has experienced an unprecedented boom in housing. There would have been no better time to sell a house there.

Now, with coronavirus and the quake, good luck even selling for what you owe on your house, if it

gets sold at all. But at least now you can still leave in a motorized vehicle.

When we delay our obedience to God, the cost of obedience will only increase. The easiest time to obey him is now.

If you thought it was hard to listen to him when times were good compared to now, wait until they are even worse.

But I pray this is the last warning I am called to give to the I-15 corridor.

I have spent so much time and love trying to help people see the danger they are in; to share with them information they have not merited to help guide them to greater safety, peace, and joy.

Almost everyone ignores almost everything I produce. I can't spend more time on these things, which are so basic and of which I have spoken so much already. Every minute I spend repeating myself is time taken away from what I have been sent to do. I have to minister to those who have lived worthy of and need more than the basics.

It hurts to keep doing this. I don't care so much about the incessant mocking. I feel sorry for those who are so blind:

7 ...Do not fear the reproach of men; be undaunted by their ridicule.

8 For the moth shall consume them like a garment; moths shall devour them like wool.

(Isaiah 26)

It hurts because it takes spiritual resources to do this. It requires an outpouring of love to push back against judgment. It costs something to intercede. It takes the virtue out of you (see Luke 6:19 and Luke 8:46). It is exhausting. And I have other things that I need to do.

You need to understand something. God is bound in what he can do by the character he possesses, which is where his power comes from. There are things he simply can't do, or else he would cease to be God:

"What, do ye suppose that mercy can rob justice? I say unto you, Nay; not one whit. If so, God would cease to be God." (Mormon 9:19)

"And if there were miracles wrought then, why
has God ceased to be a God of miracles and yet
be an unchangeable Being? And behold, I say
unto you he changeth not; if so he would cease
to be God; and he ceaseth not to be God, and is a
God of miracles." (Mormon 9:19, see also Alma
42:13,22)

God withholds his judgment until there is
nothing left that he can do. His answer to the
question "when will destruction be poured out"
is always "when nothing more can be done."

When the most helpful, loving thing is to expose
people to a greater share of the consequences
they have merited, that is when the disasters
start in earnest.

When the Lord told me this morning to warn

you yet again, I failed to find words I have not already said on this blog. And that is a very bad thing for you.

There is a list of things he can do to warn you.

Once he gets to the end of the list, you are officially "ripe for destruction." At that point, there is no more left he can do for you without ceasing to be God. At that point, you are fully turned over to the consequences of your choices.

If you are on the I-15 corridor, you have reached the "what good will mercy do" point. The time to leave without negative consequences has passed. You have greatly increased the cost of your move through your stiff-necked delays. That price will only get higher, and there will be

a time when it is too late.

To those in the I-15 corridor, you have been left without excuse. If you ignore this warning, everything that comes to you will be exactly what you deserve. At this point, justice can no longer be withheld without God ceasing to be God.

10 Though favor be shown the wicked, they will not learn righteousness; in a land of uprightness they remain perverse and see not the glory of Jehovah.

11 O Jehovah, your hand is lifted up, but they perceive it not.

Let them perceive with dismay your zeal for your people when the fire prepared for your enemies

consumes them. (Isaiah 26, Gileadi Translation)

Act now.
