



TRAUMA HAS A BIG IMPACT

The Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) Study, conducted by the CDC and Kaiser Permanente, revealed that the more an individual is exposed to a variety of stressful and potentially traumatic experiences, the greater the risk for chronic health conditions and health-risk behaviors later in life effecting family, work, school and more.



61%
About 61% of adults surveyed across 25 states reported that they had experienced at least one type of ACE, and nearly 1 in 6 reported they had experienced four or more types of ACEs.



2/3
Two-thirds of adults in addiction treatment experienced child abuse and neglect.



90%
Up to 90% of people who receive public mental health care have been exposed to trauma.



2.5 TIMES
Children with trauma experiences are 2.5 times more likely to have repeated a grade in school.



BILLIONS
The economic and social costs to families, communities, and society totals hundreds of billions of dollars each year.







BECOME INFORMED THROUGH TRAUMA 101






Understand what it means to be trustworthy




DONATE FURNITURE OR APPLIANCES
When you donate a couch or an appliance, that can equal about the cost of 1 child abuse education and prevention class at The Parenting Place.

Donation Warehouse picks up donations five days per week and it is FREE for furniture and working appliances (in the Missoula area).



BUYING FURNITURE FROM DONATION WAREHOUSE SUPPORTS PARENT EDUCATION
Donation Warehouse sells approximately 1,000 furniture items a month, from couches to chairs to bed frames. Each item sold helps fund a local class about child abuse prevention and education.



REDUCE, REUSE, & RECYCLE FOR A CAUSE
Donation Warehouse believes in being as efficient as possible. They take used parts from non-working appliances to help us refurbish other appliances.

The Parenting Place does the same with their budget. They optimize their bottom line to ensure that there are always funds to allow anyone to take one of their education and prevention classes.
