Potential Threat to CMR High School - UPDATE

GREAT FALLS, MT – This afternoon, detectives from the Great Falls Police Department (GFPD) identified the person responsible for the potential threat to CMR High School. Shortly after the individual was identified, patrol officers quickly located the individual and transported him to the police department.

Henry Douglas Lenning, 56 YOA, was eventually arrested and charged with Felony Intimidation. In order to provide integrity to the case, further details will not be released at this time. Detectives, including School Resource Officers, are confident the threat to CMR High School has been identified and resolved.

Tom Moore, Superintendent of Great Falls Public Schools, has determined there will be no change in school schedules as a result of this incident.

This was a coordinated effort between school officials and the GFPD. While not all of these investigations can be resolved this quickly, school officials and the GFPD appreciate the public's support and patience.
