Mobile Disaster Recovery Center in Fromberg Moving to Red Lodge

Helena, Mont. – The Mobile Disaster Recovery Center (MDRC) at Fromberg Methodist Church will be relocating to Red Lodge over the weekend.

The current MDRC in Fromberg, located at 14 Montana Ave., will close on Saturday, Aug. 20 at 5 p.m. It will move operations to Church of the Rockies, 7193 US Hwy 212 in Red Lodge, MT 59068 and open Monday, Aug. 22 with the following hours of operation:

12 p.m. to 6 p.m., Monday, Aug. 22

9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Tuesday – Friday Aug. 23-Aug. 26

9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 27

9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday, Aug. 29

Homeowners and renters in Carbon, Park, Stillwater, and Yellowstone counties can apply for FEMA assistance online at disasterassistance.gov, by calling 800-621-3362 or by using the [FEMA mobile app](#). Disaster survivors have until Aug. 29, 2022 to apply for FEMA assistance.
