US 287 North of Augusta project open house

AUGUSTA, Mont. - The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) invites the public to an open house for the US 287 North of Augusta project. This event will provide an opportunity for members of the community to learn more about the project, ask questions, and connect with the project team.

Open House May 28, 4 to 7 p.m. Augusta Community Center 132 Main Street Augusta, MT 59410

MDT and its consultants, DOWL and Great West Engineering, are designing roadway and safety improvements for US Highway 287 (US 287), north of Augusta. The project will reconstruct the roadway, realign segments, and update older portions of US 287 between Augusta and Choteau.

The US 287: North of Augusta project will include a new bridge over the Sun River, minor approach construction, and irrigation work to accommodate the highway improvements. Safety enhancements planned for the roadway include wider shoulders, flattened slopes, and improved alignment. These improvements will reduce hazards and improve the condition of the roadway.

The project is in the design stage. A construction date is currently unknown.

The Montana Department of Transportation will make reasonable accommodations for persons with disabilities who wish to participate in the open house or need an alternative accessible format of this notice.
