

The Helena Public Schools are committed to continual improvement in every regard, including revisiting our plans for athletic/activity events to ensure that we are constantly considering needed changes as they ongoing pandemic continues. For this reason, we have made the following changes to our Lewis and Clark County Health Department approved Spectator Plan. Beginning with today crosstown JV soccer matches, all in town participants will continue to be provided with two spectator passes. Those two passes will now be transferrable to any immediate family member including parents, step-parents, siblings and etc.

In addition, The Helena Public Schools will make available one spectator pass for each visiting participant. These passes will allow a limited number of visiting spectators while ensuring that we remain at/below 250 total spectators limit. Out of town guests will be asked to socially distance, wear appropriate face coverings and leave the facility at the conclusion of their participants activity. Pass lists will need to be provided by visiting teams prior to any out of town fan admission to a Helena School activity. With this change, we expect that we will be at capacity for spectators with up to 250 spectators accounted for in association with events.
