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Migratory bird hikes and events at Giant Springs State Park

GREAT FALLS – A weekend of fun events to celebrate and learn about the migratory birds that pass through and live at Giant Springs State Park will be held on May 1 & 2.

The free events begin with guided hikes led by members of the Upper Missouri Breaks Audubon Society. Hikes will depart from the Ranger Station in the park on Saturday morning at 6:00, 7:00, and 8:00 AM. Bring your binoculars or borrow a pair from the park and be ready to hike with some talented birders. The hikes are limited so please call the Ranger Station to reserve a spot 406-727-1212.

Later on Saturday the park will be hosting kids bird activities in Giant Springs from 1:00-3:00. Bring the family and see who survives the Great Migration Challenge or see how human feet compare to bird's feet with a fun track activity.

Throughout the weekend visitors are welcome to participate in self-guided walks through the park with signage provided by the Audubon Society. Borrow some sanitized binoculars, use your powers of observation and follow along with a Bird Bingo game as you walk the trails.

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
