



## CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

Should the Defendant be released on his own recognizance or on bail, the following conditions shall be adhered to:

1. Defendant shall obey all laws at all times;
2. Defendant shall contact his attorney at least once a week;
3. Defendant shall maintain or actively seek employment;
4. Defendant shall stay in school;
5. Defendant shall not possess or consume alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs, except as prescribed by a licensed physician;
6. Defendant shall not enter any establishment where alcohol is a chief item of sale;
7. Defendant shall not associate with persons who use alcohol, illicit drugs or other intoxicants;
8. Defendant shall remain in the custody of \_\_\_\_\_, who agrees to supervise the defendant and report any violation of a release condition to the Court;
9. Defendant shall not leave the State of Montana/Cascade County during the pendency of this action except with the written permission of the Court;
10. Defendant shall not associate with \_\_\_\_\_;
11. Defendant shall attend all court hearings;
12. Defendant shall avoid all contact with any alleged victim or potential prosecution witness in this case, including by phone call, text message, mail, e-mail, social media, or through a third person;
13. Defendant shall observe a 8am-6am curfew;
14. Defendant shall reside at \_\_\_\_\_;

15. Defendant shall not operate a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license;
16. Defendant shall not possess, be in control of, purchase, or attempt to purchase any firearms, destructive devices or other dangerous weapons, including ammunition, black powder, or explosive devices, as defined by state or federal law;
17. Prior to release, Defendant shall be equipped with, comply with, and begin active alcohol monitoring by use of the SCRAM device, the Remote Alcohol Testing device, Soberlink device, or participation in the 24/7 Program at the Cascade County Sheriff's Office. The Defendant shall be solely responsible for paying any costs associated with alcohol monitoring. Failure to begin monitoring within 24 hours or terminating monitoring without leave of the Court, including termination of services for failure to pay for monitoring, will result in a bail revocation. Defendant shall provide proof of monitoring sign up to the Cascade County Attorney's Office within 24 hours of beginning monitoring;
18. Prior to release from custody, the Defendant shall be equipped with, comply with, and begin active GPS (Global Positioning Satellite) monitoring by use of an ankle monitor or other device capable of determining his position by use of GPS technology. The Defendant shall be solely responsible for paying any costs associated with GPS monitoring. Terminating monitoring without leave of the Court, including termination of services for failure to pay for monitoring, will result in a bail revocation. Defendant shall provide proof of monitoring sign up to the Cascade County Attorney's Office within 24 hours of beginning monitoring;
19. Defendant shall not have contact with any individual under the age of eighteen (18);
20. If supervised by the Department of Corrections, within 24 hours of release, the Defendant shall report to his probation officer, and otherwise abide by all rules and regulations of Adult Probation and Parole and report to Adult Probation and Parole as required;
21. Defendant shall surrender his U.S. Passport to the Cascade County Sheriff;

- \_\_\_\_\_ 22. If the Defendant does not otherwise have health care coverage, immediately proceed to Medicaid offices to sign up for eligibility.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 23. Upon notification of Medicaid eligibility (or if Defendant already has appropriate health care coverage) obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 24. If the Defendant is not already employed, within 24 hours of release from custody the Defendant shall find employment.
- ✓ \_\_\_\_\_ 25. After the Defendant posts bond, the Defendant is **HEREBY ORDERED** to appear in the Eighth Judicial District Court, Cascade County, located in the Cascade County Court House, 415 2nd Ave., N., Great Falls, Montana, not later than the first Monday after release at 1:00 p.m. for an initial appearance.
- ✓ \_\_\_\_\_ 26. The Defendant is **FURTHER ORDERED** to present himself to the Cascade County Sheriff's Office, within two hours before or after the initial appearance hearing, to be fingerprinted, photographed and booked.
