Due to the COVID-19 emergency, and new guidance from the Federal Government released April 2021, your SNAP benefits are being temporarily increased based on your household size of <8>. As a result, you are being issued a supplemental benefit in the amount of <\$515.00>. This is in addition to the regular SNAP benefit you already received for <July>. This is only a temporary increase for the month of <July>.

You have been receiving the maximum allowable SNAP benefit for your household size pursuant to the Families First Coronavirus Response Act. This temporary additional benefit expires on August 1, 2021. Beginning in August 2021, you will receive your standard monthly SNAP benefit, with a 15 percent increase for the months of August and September 2021. You will return to your standard SNAP monthly benefit amount beginning October 2021.
