The State of Montana, by and through the Cascade County Attorney, pursuant to M.C.A. §§ 46-11-101(1), 46-11-401(1), 46-1-202(6), and 46-11-401(3), hereby files this complaint against the above-named Defendant in the above-captioned Justice Court for purposes of M.C.A. § 46-10-105(1), pending filing of an Information and Affidavit in District Court pursuant to M.C.A. §§ 46-11-101(3), 46-11-201, and 46-11-203. This complaint consists of this pleading and the attached law enforcement citation form(s) and probable cause affidavit(s) which by this reference are hereby incorporated herein as if set forth in their entirety.

The State further moves the Court for a finding of probable cause and to set bail in this matter pursuant to M.C.A. §§ 46-9-109 and 46-9-301. This Defendant has been charged with the following offenses:

COUNT I: CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS DRUGS, a Felony, in violation of M.C.A. § 45-9-102. A person convicted of criminal possession of dangerous drugs shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term not to exceed 5 years or be fined an amount not to exceed \$5,000, or both.

COUNT II: CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA, a Misdemeanor, in violation of M.C.A. § 45-10-103. A person convicted of this offense shall be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than six months, fined not more than \$500, or both.

COUNT III: CRIMINAL CHILD ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of M.C.A. § 45-5-628(1)(d). A person convicted of this offense shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$50,000 or be imprisoned in the state prison for a term not to exceed 10 years, or both.

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT

As outlined in the attached probable cause affidavit, on May 27, 2021 MHP Trooper Palen observed a vehicle without visible registration on I-15 in Cascade County, Montana. Trooper Palen made contact with two males who had exited the

vehicle and advised that the vehicle was overheating. The older male was identified

as Christopher Offerdahl and the younger male was his 14 year old son, GO. Trooper

Palen observed that Offerdahl seemed nervous and continued to reach towards the

driver's seat. Trooper Palen was advised that Offerdahl had numerous warrants for

his arrest. Trooper Palen asked Offerdahl if there was anything in the vehicle he

should know about. Offerdahl advised that his girlfriend, Tiffany Wells, was hiding

in the trunk because she had outstanding warrant and was on probation. Trooper

Palen received permission to search the vehicle from Offerdahl. Trooper Palen

retrieved Wells from the trunk.

During the search of the vehicle, Trooper Palen located multiple glass pipes

used to ingest methamphetamine, a scale, a mirror with residue, a Ziploc bag

containing suspected methamphetamine and a small container containing suspected

methamphetamine. Both substances tested positive for methamphetamine. Both

Offerdahl and Wells claimed possession of the items and admitted recent meth use.

GO, the 14 year old son of Offerdahl, was exposed to the presence of

methamphetamine in the vehicle.

For the foregoing reasons, the State respectfully requests bond in the amount

of 7,500.
