**INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER  
(Count 1)**  
Title 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153(a), 1112(a)  
(Penalty: Eight years of imprisonment,  
\$250,000 fine, and three years of  
supervised release)

**POSSESSION OF AN UNREGISTERED  
FIREARM (Count 2)**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT 1

That on or about December 28, 2024, at or near Browning, in Glacier County, in the State and District of Montana, and within the exterior boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, being Indian Country, the defendant, TREYSON LEE SHARP, an Indian person, without due caution and circumspection, killed Jane Doe, in the commission of a lawful act that might produce death, that is, he discharged a loaded firearm while pointing it at Jane Doe, killing her, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153(a) and 1112(a).

COUNT 2

That on or about December 28, 2024, at or near Browning, in Glacier County, in the State and District of Montana, and within the exterior boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, being Indian Country, the defendant, TREYSON LEE SHARP, knowingly possessed a weapon made from a shotgun, which the defendant knew had an overall length of less than 26 inches and a barrel of less than 18 inches, which was not registered to him in the National Firearm Registration and Transfer Record, in violation of 26 U.S.C. §§ 5841 and 5861(d).


FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of any offense listed in this indictment, the defendant, TREYSON LEE SHARP, shall forfeit, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d), any firearms and ammunition involved in or used in any knowing violation of said offense.
