Of the total funding requested, the Conrad Library would receive \$219,008, plus an inflationary factor allowed by Montana law, and the Valier Library would receive \$93,860, plus an inflationary factor allowed by Montana law. Additional Information: In 2012, the voters approved a levy request which expired in 2021. These additional funds will be used to purchase fire trucks for the increased safety and protection of all Pondera County rural residents and their property. If approved by the voters, the additional levy will be effective July 1, 2022.
