# Understanding Our Crosstabs

Our heatmap crosstabs show how different groups answered a survey question.

- **Rows = Answers (like Trump or Harris)**
- **Columns = Groups (like age, party, or location)**
- **Bright boxes = Strongest result in that group or column**

### In This Example:

Of those surveyed who voted in the last election:

- **91.1%** of Republicans voted for Donald Trump
- **66.1%** of Walden supporters voted for Kamala Harris

This can identify both **strength and weakness**—and where **opportunities or challenges** may lie.

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



**Q1. First, are you or any member of your immediate family a member of the press, an elected official, a candidate, or an employee of a political campaign?**




**Q2. Are you registered to vote in the State of Montana?**





### Q3. How likely are you to vote in the 2026 Midterm Elections for Federal, State, and Local Elections?







**Q9. If the election for the United States Congress were held today, for which party's candidate would you vote in your congressional district?**






















