As with most African-Americans trying to trace their family history, I was frustrated by the lack of published information on Black people prior to that found in the 1870 census. After reading a number of books and consulting expert genealogists, I decided that I needed to look at county court minutes to see if I could trace my slave ancestors through wills, inventories, sales, and gifts of the slaveowner's family. Therefore I compiled this list of slave sales from Burke County North Carolina in order to assist other researchers from this area by bringing this information together in one printed document. Although some of this information is published in other books, there is no one source that covers as many years as does this one and dedicated only to this subject.

The citations were so numerous and intricate that I found myself looking through the transactions of many families over sixty years. The fact that the court house was burned by Union soldiers during the Civil War, thereby destroying many records, hindered my findings somewhat. I did not find any records of transactions from 1851-1865. In spite of these problems, I did learn some interesting things. Among them is the fact that the family a slave started out with was not necessarily the one with which he/she ended up. Also, the surname that a Black person used following slavery was not always that of his last owner. In many cases, although separated from one another, many slaves maintained family relationships and a surname over several generations and through several owners. Sometimes ex slaves chose a surname other than that of a former owner for various reasons.

This project was very interesting and informative. I was able to do it at minimal expense by having the microfilm records sent to me at the nearest Latter Day Saints (LDS) Family History Center in Annandale Virginia. The volunteers who worked there were cooperative and very helpful.

I transcribed the names as accurately as possible considering the poor quality of the copy (faded, blurred, and or torn) and the illegibility of the handwriting in some cases. I apologize for any errors and suggest that serious researchers look at the microfilm or original documents for themselves. Another reason for looking at the documentation is the fact that additional information is available. Some slave inventories are listed in the court minutes that were not transcribed here. If there was no dispensation of the slaves I did not include those lists in this document. Also there are some lists that included the ages of the slaves and other pertinent information about them as well as prices at which they were sold. I did, however, include the descriptive terms, boy, girl, woman, man, etc. if there was such information available to aid the researcher in determining the age of a particular slave. These terms have proven fairly reliable in my own research.

The layout of the data is as follows: The list is in alphabetical order by the names of the sellers. Column 1: Name of

the seller, Column 2: Name and description of slave (indented and under the seller's name), Column 3: Date of the actual transaction, Column 4: Name of the purchaser (directly adjacent to that of the slave), and Column 5: Date of the term of court in which the transaction was recorded. In some cases, one or the other of these dates is missing because it did not appear on the microfilm. There are some instances where Column 2 will say "three negroes", "several slaves", or some other similar phrase because the individual slave names were not listed. Hopefully by having the name of the seller, purchaser, and year of the transaction, the researcher can find this information helpful also.
