**CONSENT ORDER MODIFYING
BOND**

This matter is before the Court on motion of defendants, by and through undersigned counsel, to modify the terms and conditions of her bond. Specifically, the defendant seeks to modify her bond to permit her to reside in the state of Florida. The grounds for the motion are that the defendant, has found employment in the state Florida that would permit her to provide for herself and her family.

Currently, the defendant is subject to home detention monitoring. The defendant's bond has been modified once already, permitting her to travel to Florida for a job interview, as well as permitting her to travel to states that border South Carolina to work for periods of two (2) week intervals, requiring her to check in with Home Detention every two (2) weeks.

I find that the defendant's attorneys and the Horry County Solicitor's Office have consented to a modification of the terms and conditions of the bonds as follows:

1. The defendant shall continue to be monitored by Home Detention;
2. The defendant shall be required to provide Home Detention with a Florida address, and immediately notify Home Detention with any change of address;
3. The defendant shall provide Home Detention with the employer's name and address, and shall provide Home Detention with verification of her

employment to the satisfaction of Home Detention;

4. If the defendant's employment status or living status changes, she will immediately notify home detention. Failure to do so will be a violation of bond;
5. The defendant shall consent to waive extradition from Florida in the event of a violation of Home Detention; and
6. The defendant shall check in with Home Detention at the discretion of Home Detention, at least once each month for any required drug tests and to pay home detention fees.

Based upon the foregoing, **IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the defendants bond is modified consistent with the terms and conditions as set forth herein above, and as consented to by both the defense and the State;
