BOARD OF YAKIMA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION

IN THE MATTER OF CALLING AN EMS LEVY AUTHORIZATION ELECTION FOR TAX YEARS 2024-2029

164-2022

WHEREAS, RCW 84.52.069, authorize counties, with voter approval, to impose regular property tax levies on real and personal property within the county, at rates of up to fifty cents per thousand dollars of assessed value, for the provision of emergency medical care or emergency medical services: and,

WHEREAS, Yakima County currently levies such taxes, under the same authority, at the rate of twenty-five cents per thousand dollars of assessed value, using the proceeds thereof to provide high quality emergency medical services to the citizens of Yakima County: and,

WHEREAS the voter approval previously granted for such levies will expire December 31, 2023; and,

WHEREAS the submission of the authorizing ballot proposition to county voters under this statute requires approval of the legislative body of each city within the county having a population of fifty thousand or more; and,

WHEREAS the Yakima County Emergency Medical Services Administrative Board have expressed their support for the submission of the proposition to Yakima County voters; and,

WHEREAS the submission of such a proposition to the voters of Yakima County at the November 8, 2022, general election is therefore found to be in the best interests of the people of Yakima County; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that at the general election to be held November 8, 2022, there shall be placed before the voters of Yakima County a ballot proposition substantially as follows:

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE LEVIES:

Shall the County of Yakima be authorized to continue to impose regular property tax levies of twenty-five cents per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.25/\$1,000.00) beginning January 1, 2024, and ending December 31, 2029, the proceeds to be used to provide emergency medical care or emergency medical services, according to RCW 84.52.069?

SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

Yakima County has imposed an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Levy for the past 32 years at the rate of \$0.25 per one-thousand dollars of the assessed value of property. The recommendation of the EMS Administration Board, as supported by the Yakima County Fire Commissioner's Association and the Yakima County Fire Chiefs, is to recommend approval of the placement of an EMS Levy on the ballot at the current rate for a period of six years.

This resolution is required as per RCW 84.52.069(4) for general purpose levies.

A RESOLUTION

approving Yakima County's placement of a proposed Emergency Medical Services (EMS) levy on the ballot before December 31, 2022, for a county-wide vote pursuant to RCW 84.52.169.

WHEREAS, Yakima County has imposed an EMS levy for the past 32 years at the rate of \$0.25 per one-thousand dollars of the assessed value of property; and

WHEREAS, the current EMS levy expires on December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima utilizes funds from this levy in order to provide emergency medical services to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need for quality emergency medical services, and the elimination of this resource would reduce the ability of the City to continue to deliver the current level of quality emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, under RCW 84.52.069(4), Yakima County may not place this levy on the ballot without the approval of the legislative authority of a majority of at least 75 percent of all cities exceeding 50,000 in population within the County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima is located within Yakima County and has a population in excess of 50,000 persons; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City of Yakima to approve Yakima County's placement of the EMS levy on the ballot; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City of Yakima approves the placement of a proposed Emergency Medical Services levy on a county-wide ballot, at the current rate of \$0.25 per one-thousand dollars of the assessed value of property for a term of six-years, before December 31, 2022.
