

Fruitvale Housing is the new construction of <u>54 units</u> of housing located at <u>1116 Fruitvale Blvd in</u> Yakima, WA. The project will be one four story building with a new YHA office on the first floor.

The project will create:



- 27 units of housing for general low income and 27 units set aside for households existing homelessness for a total of 54 units
- o 23 studio units
- o 23 1 Bedroom units
- 8 2 Bedroom units
- Community room, community kitchen, onsite laundry, on-site manager's office and onsite Resident Services coordinator
- o 2500 SF of new office space for YHA on the ground floor
- 14 residents will be assisted with Project Based Housing Vouchers
- The Resident Services Coordinator will be provided through a partnership with Yakima
 Neighborhood Health Services to provide supportive services to residents of the building.
- Department of Ecology provided \$100,000 grant to YHA for environmental remediation of a former machine shop on the site.
