

Free PFAS Livestock Product Testing

Sign Up By February 27, 2026.

Sample collection on Saturday, March 7.
Home pickup available.

In our previous 3 rounds of sampling, we found PFAS in eggs laid by backyard hens and ducks who drank PFAS-contaminated water. We also found PFAS in home-raised meat. We recommended some families eat less of their home-raised eggs and meat because of the PFAS levels.

What We Can Do:

- Test your home-raised eggs or meat for PFAS.
- Re-test eggs or meat for past participants to check that the actions you took lowered PFAS levels in your food.

What You Get:

- Your test results.
- A free consult on your test results from Washington State Department of Health (DOH), including advice on the safety of eating the meat or eggs.



To Qualify, You Must:



Live in East Selah and have PFAS in your water higher than at least one of these values:

- PFOS: 4 ppt or ng/L
- PFOA: 4 ppt or ng/L
- PFHxS: 10 ppt or ng/L
- PFNA: 10 ppt or ng/L



Use the contaminated water to raise animals or eggs at home for yourself, your family, or friends to eat (not commercial production).
