THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

Count IX

That on or about May 1, 2014, at or near Tanana in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, NATHANIAL L. KANGAS and ARVIN M. KANGAS, acting as a principal or accomplice, did knowingly alter physical evidence with the intent to impair its verity or availability in an official proceeding or criminal investigation and/or did any such act with the intent to prevent the institution of an official proceeding, to wit : manipulated and/or re-positioned a Glock .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol bearing SN VBU709, ultimately recovered from under the body of Alaska State Trooper Scott Johnson, after Sergeant Johnson had been fatally wounded.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.610(a)(1) and/or (4) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count X

That on or about May 1, 2014, at or near Tanana in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, NATHANIAL L. KANGAS and ARVIN M. KANGAS, acting as a principal or accomplice, did knowingly alter physical evidence with the intent to impair its verity or availability in an official proceeding or criminal investigation and/or did any such act with the intent to prevent the institution of an official proceeding, to

wit : manipulated and/or re-positioned a Glock .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol bearing SN MMB813, ultimately recovered from the body of Alaska State Trooper Gabe Rich, after Trooper Rich had been fatally wounded.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.610(a)(1) and/or (4) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count XI

That on or about May 1, 2014, at or near Tanana in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, NATHANIAL L. KANGAS and ARVIN M. KANGAS, acting as a principal or accomplice, did knowingly destroy, alter, suppress, conceal, or remove physical evidence with intent to impair its verity or availability in an official proceeding or a criminal investigation, and/or did any such act with the intent to prevent the institution of an official proceeding to wit: removed marijuana plants and seeds from the scene, after Alaska State Trooper Sergeant Scott Johnson and Trooper Gabriel Rich were fatally wounded.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.610(a)(1) and/or (4) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count XII

That on or about May 1, 2014, at or near Tanana in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, ARVIN M. KANGAS, rendered assistance to a person who had committed a crime punishable as a felony with intent to hinder the apprehension, prosecution, conviction, or punishment of that person to wit: manipulated and/or re-positioned a Glock .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol bearing SN VBU709, ultimately recovered from under the body of Alaska State Trooper Sergeant Scott Johnson, after Sergeant Johnson had been fatally wounded.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.770(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count XIII

That on or about May 1, 2014, at or near Tanana in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, ARVIN M. KANGAS, rendered assistance to a person who had committed a crime punishable as a felony with intent to hinder the apprehension, prosecution, conviction, or punishment of that person to wit: manipulated and/or re-positioned a Glock .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol bearing SN MMB813, ultimately recovered from the body of Alaska State Trooper Gabriel Rich, after Trooper Rich had been fatally wounded.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.770(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.



Count XIV

That on or about May 1, 2014, at or near Tanana in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, ARVIN M. KANGAS rendered assistance to a person who had committed a crime punishable as a felony with intent to hinder the apprehension, prosecution, conviction, or punishment of that person to wit: removed marijuana plants and seeds from the scene, after the troopers were killed.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.56.770(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.
