Chesapeake Bay Estates Public Water Supply.

The permit would authorize the applicant to withdraw a maximum of 4,100,000 gallons per year and 940,000 gallons per month from the Potomac aquifer. The ground water withdrawal will support a non-municipal public water supply. The top of the Potomac aguifer at the

proposed withdrawal site was determined to be 679 feet below land surface. An aquifer is a body of rock or layer of sediment in the ground in which ground water is stored and transported. DEQ has made a tentative decision to issue the permit. The draft permit can be viewed at https://www.deq.virginia.gov/permits/public-no tices/water/water-withdrawal. AFFECTED AREA: Computer modeling pre-

dicts that the aquifer will not experience one foot of drawdown due to the withdrawal.

HOW TO COMMENT AND/OR REQUEST A PUBLIC HEARING: DEQ accepts comments

and requests for public hearing by hand-deliv-

ery, e-mail, or postal mail. All comments and requests must be in writing and be received by DEQ during the comment period. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses or email addresses of the commenter/requester

and of all persons represented by the com-menter/requester. A request for public hearing must also include: 1) The reason why a public hearing is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. A public hearing may be held, including another com-ment period, if public response is significant,

based on individual requests for a public hearing, and there are substantial, disputed issues

relevant to the permit.
