PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

February 10, 2026

I, Sheriff Jeff Spencer, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

UPON MY OATH, AND UNDER PENALTIES OF PERJURY, state as follows:

1. I have probable cause to believe that Michael Eugene Frisbie of Mercer County, committed the offense(s) of: Resisting or Interfering with an Arrest, RSMO 575.150
2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows: On February 9, 2026 in Mercer County Frisbie resisted arrest by fleeing from Harrison County Sheriff Trevor Place. Sheriff Place had attempted to initiate a traffic stop in Harrison County. Frisbie is suspect in numerous Felony Burglaries in Harrison County. Sheriff Place activated his lights and siren attempting to stop Frisbie's vehicle. A pursuit ensued from Harrison County traveling into Mercer County. The pursuit came to an end on Egret Lane in Mercer County where Sheriff Place was unable to negotiate a turn causing him to crash. Sheriff Place was injured during the crash. Confidential informants 1-26, and 2-26 stated Frisbie was the driver of the truck pursued by Sheriff Place. Both informants indicated Frisbie has been stealing items in Harrison and Mercer County. Frisbie resisted an arrest for a felony, and fled in such a manner he caused serious physical injury to Sheriff Trevor Place.
