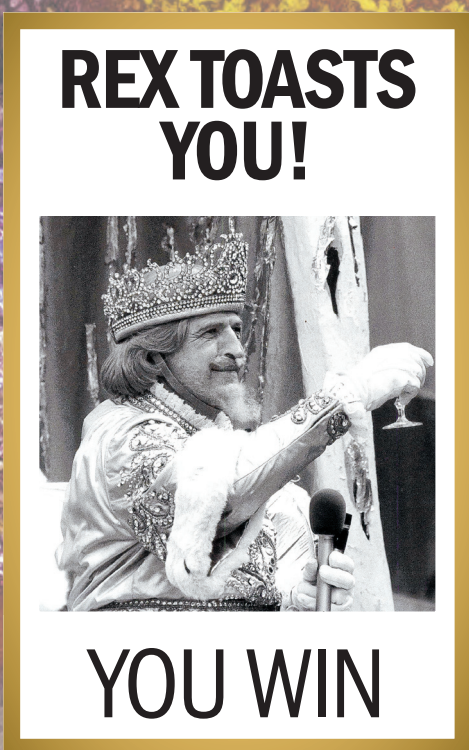
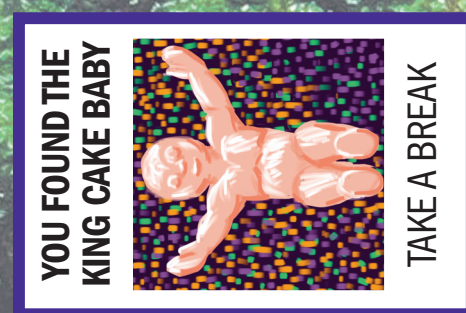
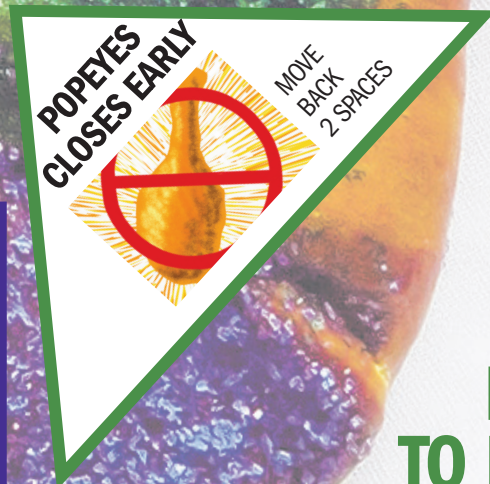
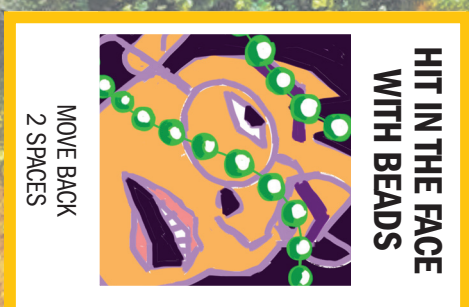
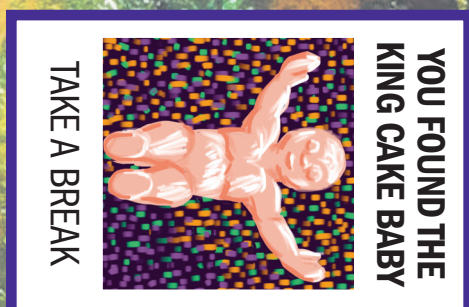
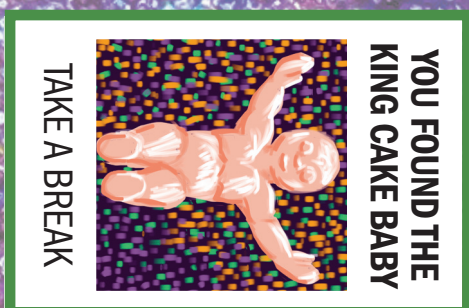
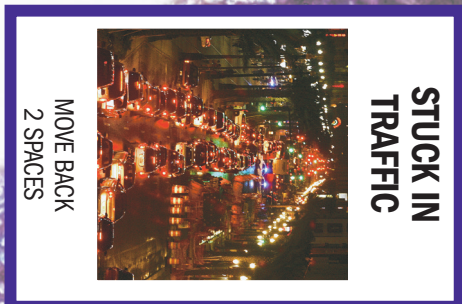


LIFE'S A PARADE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- A token for each player. Try a king cake baby or a bottle cap. A doubloon. Or a chicken bone.
- A single dice, or a dice-throwing app on your phone

HOW TO PLAY
