The three finalists will be brought to New Orleans to interview in person with the Mayor in the coming weeks as the IACP completes the full background investigation. Once a finalist has been selected, my office will continue to work with Council staff and the Clerk of Council to follow the confirmation processes outlined in the Home Rule Charter, Section 4-106 of City Code, and City Council Rule 56.

Finally, the IACP will begin reaching out to Councilmembers this week to schedule individual briefings for you and your staff. These briefings can be used to address any questions you may have regarding the search process and next steps, including requesting the IACP to appear at a future committee meeting.
