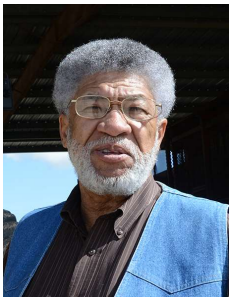

Louisiana is the first state in America where sugar was planted – tracing its roots back more than 230 years.

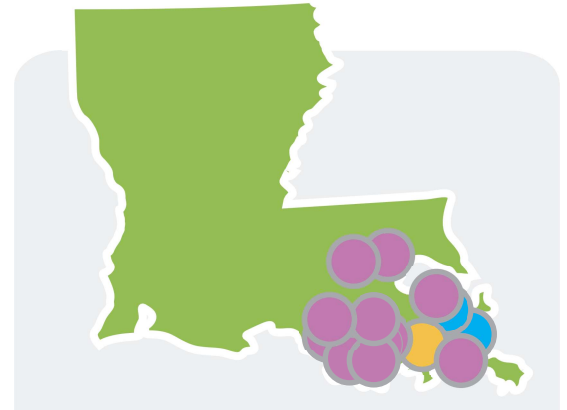
