Academic Performance





Norfolk Public Schools scored at or above average in nearly all subject and grade levels.


Spring 2025 MAP Science NPS & National Comparison




2025 Spring MAP Math NPS & National Comparison




2025 Spring MAP Reading NPS & National Comparison

- Norfolk Public Schools is a fiscally conservative school district. Staffing costs make up approximately 84% of our budget.
- Our \$0.925 levy places us among the lowest in the state for districts of similar size, reflecting our commitment to responsible fiscal stewardship.
