Stanton woman serves auxiliary for 72 years

STANTON — Wilma Dopson has been a flag-waving member of the American Legion Auxiliary longer than a lot of people have been alive.

The 93-year-old was raised on a

farm southeast of Norfolk and graduated from Norfolk High School in 1944. She joined Stanton's Auxiliary 88 in 1947, the same year she married Virgil Hansen.

He joined the Navy in August of 1943 and worked on the radar system of the USS Denver during World War II. He was discharged in the spring of 1946, and the couple were married the following year.

Dopson credits her late mother-inlaw for "talking her into joining" the

"She was in the auxiliary because of her son's service," Dopson said. In the past 72 years, Dopson has

almost every office organization offers, including color bearer, a duty she particularly enjoyed.

"It was always an honor to carry the flag during the opening and closing ceremonies," she said.

She's also currently the club's treasurer.

Through the years, auxiliary members have participated in a variety of activities, including volunteering at the Norfolk Veterans Home and sponsoring County Government Day.

Although membership numbers aren't what they were at one time, the organization is still active, and members still meet to conduct

"It's hard to keep some of the clubs going," she said. "Everyone is so busy."

Dopson's service doesn't stop with the American Legion Auxiliary. She's also a 40-year member of the VFW Auxiliary in Stanton.




