Motion carried 6:0.

Motion to approve the attached Property Tax Authority Resolution, resulting in an increase to the NPS' property tax request authority by an additional 5% at 12:48 PM passed with a motion by Teri Bauer and a second by Dr. Patti Gubbels. Motion carried 5:1. Motion to approve the Superintendent to sign the 125 Plan Resolutions to increase FSA plan limits to comply with federal regulations at 12:53 PM passed with a motion by Steve McNally and a second by Dr. Patti Gubbels. Motion carried 6:0. Motion to accept the resignation of Scott Sigel, effective August 7th, 2026, due to extreme extenuating circumstances at 12:53 PM failed with a motion by Tom Stanton and a second by Steve McNally. Motion failed 0:6. The next regular meeting of the Board of Education will be September 14th, 2026.
