What Is Pool Cool?

Pool Cool is a fun sun safety program made just for kids. Did you know that skin cancer is the most common cancer in the United States? The good news is that about 9 out of 10 skin cancer cases can be prevented just by protecting your skin from the sun.

Pool Cool teaches kids 8 easy sun safety tips right at the pool. Lifeguards share short, 5-minute lessons during swimming lessons to help kids learn how to have fun in the sun safely.
