Ski and Ride Ability Assessment: Saturday, March 8th @ 10am Ski Sawmill - Morris, PA


REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

Outdoor Emergency Care Certification: 100 hours emergency care class of the National Ski Patrol offered in the fall of 2025. Consists of online modules and hands on practice.

Ski and Ride Ability Assessment: (madatory prior to OEC class enrollment) able to ride all terrain at Ski Sawmill in varied conditions and capability to learn toboggan using necessary ski/ride skills.

Time Commitment: Patrollers at Ski Sawmill are assigned to ski on a 3-week team weekend rotation (Sat and Sun shifts), plus 2 weeknights each month.

Financial: Candidates must purchase OEC course/book and CPR course fees. Patrollers pay annual national and local dues, CPR annual certification fee, and must purchase your patrol vest/jacket. Medical supplies provided by Patrol.
