I have spent the last 15 years serving the Polk and Haralson Counties and look to carry on my service through leading the Office of the District Attorney. For over a decade, I have had the honor of serving as an assistant district attorney. The past three years I have served the Tallapoosa Circuit as the Chief Assistant District Attorney. I currently serve at the Chief Prosecutor for Haralson County Probate Court, City of Bremen and City of Tallapoosa. I have previously served as the Chief Prosecutor for the City of Buchanan, making me the only attorney in history to prosecute in every court in Haralson County. Through all my duties, I oversee the prosecution of over five thousands cases each year.

I also serve as the prosecutor for the Tallapoosa Circuit Mental Health Court and serve as an advisor to the Georgia State Patrol Special Collision Reconstruction Team (SCRT). I am proud to serve all of our communities in Polk and Haralson Counties helping them to be some of the safest in the State of Georgia.

My proudest moments come when addressing children of our schools. Through in-school and out-of-the-classroom programs, I have had the opportunity to speak to thousands of youth about many aspects of the law.
