As you all know, in response to the evolving situation regarding COVID-19, the University has decided to move to remote instruction for the remainder of the spring semester. Additionally, the residence halls are closed as of March 16th and will remain closed for the remainder of the semester. Auburn University Housing values the student experience and all decisions are being made with the health and well-being of our students and residents in mind. We are grateful for your understanding as we work to implement the plan for Auburn University.

In planning for an early move-out, our priorities are to:

- 1. Maintain the health and well-being of our students and staff by adhering to guidelines set forth by the CDC regarding not gathering in large groups,
- 2. Maintain the security of the buildings and your belongings (access to buildings has currently been restricted), and
- 3. Make the move-out process as easy as possible given the circumstances.

Given these priorities, we are asking you to adhere to the following move-out schedule:

If you arrive on campus outside of your scheduled date/time, you will not have access to your building in order to minimize the number of people on campus.

As you make arrangements to checkout, please coornidate with your roommate/suitemate on times in which best supports social distancing and all other CDC guidelines.

At the time of your checkout, we ask that you:

- Bring no more than two people. Please follow CDC guidelines and do not ask those with compromised immune systems or those with symptoms of COVID-19 to assist you.
- Upon arrival, go to the main entrance of your building to pick up an express checkout packet.
- Please limit your time in the residence hall to two hours.
- Take all personal items you want from the room. In addition, remove all perishable items.
- Leave items you no longer want. Staff will dispose of or donate these items at a later date. Once your move-out date has passed you will not be able to retrieve any items left behind.
- Turn in your room keys in the express checkout envelope to the desk or place it in the dropout box. After this step, you will no longer have access to the room.
- Parking regulations during move-out allows students to park in lots other than ones for which they are
 permitted, and cars that do not have an AU permit will also be able to park in an AU lot without receiving a
 ticket.
- Campus Security will be onsite monitoring traffic flow.

Extenuating Circumstances

If you are sick or cannot return to campus and need to access your room outside of your assigned dates, you can submit a COVID-19 Item Retrieval Request at the following link:

The refund process runs once per week. It takes about five business days before it is deposited into the bank account on file.

If you have a balance due or owe Auburn University, your refund amount will be reduced.

 In the middle column, you will see "Banking Direct Deposit Information". Select this link and follow the instructions.
