We are saddened to hear of children being transferred to outside institutions for additional care because of complications and inadequate specialist physician coverage at Children's Hospital.

Issues have been raised about possible medical staff by-laws violations. As you know, physicians and the medical staff are responsible for the delivery of medical care and medical decisions within the hospital and we take this role very seriously. Of late, the medical decisions and hiring of new physicians are done without physician input. My constituents and I are concerned about current leadership methods.

We thank you and the entire board for working to reestablish Children's Hospital to its honored status and integrity with physicians and most importantly the patients we are fortunate to serve.
