Information Received: Kelli Brown with NHS, contacted me, to inform me that they were receiving complaints, concerns, involving Tully's Kennel. Also, posting on social media was indicating concerns with Tully's Kennel. Mike McKnight with Channel 6 news, also, called me to inform me of the concerns that he, and Channel 6 news were receiving involving Tully's Kennel. Basis of the complaints received involved sick pups at the facility, pups being bought and put into the facility from unlicensed dog breeders, dogs being breed in the kennel area, and then the pups being sold at the facility. Rodent problems in the boarding kennel area.

Follow-Up Action Taken: On 7-14-15, myself, and Kelli Brown with NHS, did visit withTom Westman, and Julie Tully regarding the complaint received. Inspection of the facility indicated the following non-compliant items. East outside kennel area rust and sharp points present on tin-metal. Facility must be kept in good repair and protect dogs from injury. Not all records were available for inspection.Pups appeared at the time of inspection to be healthy, and vet. care plan was up to date. Although no rodents were seen at the time of the inspection, a rodent smell was present in the boarding kennel area, a rodent control program is in place at the facility. On 7-15-15, I did stop to inspect records, all records were present on the 15th. It does appear that some pups may be originating from unlicensed breeders. A large number of pups are received through Heather Campbell, who operates a pet store in South Sioux City, Ne. Records will indicate that from last fall to present that nine individuals names are attached to the name of Heather Campbell on selling pups to Tully's over that period of time. Also, a name of a individual was found on pups sold in the month of March 2015 who is not licensed as a breeder in Nebraska. Indications, also, appear to show that dogs are being breed at the kennel facility at Tully's, pups are born at the facility, or other locations, and then sold at the Tully's location. I did inform Kelli Brown with NHS, of my findings involving the records on 7-16-15
