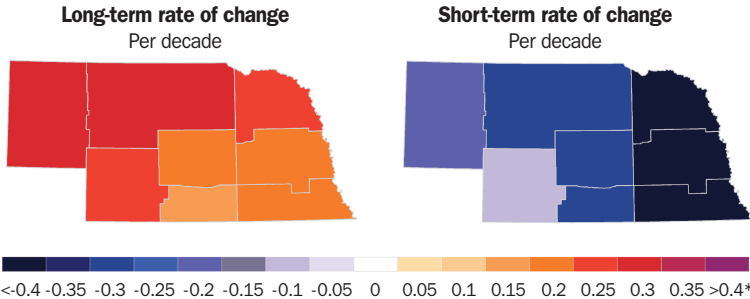


Nebraska is warming, but winter is getting cooler

Over the long term, Nebraska is warming along with the rest of the planet, but in recent decades winters have been getting cooler, driven especially by cooler Februarys. Maps show the climate trends for the state's eight climate divisions. Long-term trends are based on data from 1895 to 2016; short-term trends are based on data from 1987 to 2016.
