

## Chapter 1

I'm 74 years old, where did my life go?  
Seems like last week I was young, pretty  
AND HAPPY. Now I'm alone AND regretting most of the  
things I've done to destroy my life AND even worse  
the lives of people I love!

x My father was born in 1887, the second son & child  
of Frances & Margaret<sup>wife</sup> Kerns. which later had 4 more  
boys & 2 girls. John, Ira, MARION, BAINE, EZRA AND Bill  
Elizabeth and ALTA.

Grandpa was the son of a farmer & military man, David  
Study. AND Grandma was the daughter of a family friend.  
Grandpa was ALSO a military man, serving his country  
in the family tradition.

They made their home in western Iowa, near the town  
of Bartlett Iowa. It was Green Hollow, a man made  
road reaching deep into the hills, with dirt embankment  
raising 300 ft or higher separated by a creek so it  
deep the hills were covered in all kind of trees  
tall and full of color. The road was slim (lean)  
and one had to be careful not to drive off into

the ditch, the road extended 20 miles deep into the hills.  
Coming out at Thurman

Green Hollow was inhabited by several families  
mostly poor people who related in one way or  
another, or close friends of family. My grand  
father owned 20 acres of land that he built a  
home for his wife, he farmed the land, dug a  
well, planted fruit trees and raised chickens

goats, AND horses. Horses + Buggy were everones transportat. on

The house was A Frame house, 4 rooms on the bottom + 1 giant room on the second floor. which was turned into A Bedroom. There was No Electricity so Keresen lanterns was light, For heat they had A put Belly stove and for cooking and canning they used A wood stove then A outhouse for a toilet.

The families built A Church, just At the Entrance of the Hollow, where they all gathered on Sundays For services AND picnic together. It was Named Kings Church.

During the winter the men would leave home to look for work, the women would gather together to sew clothes AND Exchange ideas to make life better. They canned food, helped as much as they could to make sure everyone in the Hollow had food during the winter; Even shooting squirrel AND rabbits for meat. The children would gather wild mushrooms to be dried + strung up to dry; then in winter were soaked to soften to eat. Everyone had a garden AND the potatoes, were put in gunny sacks AND Buried deep in the ground + dug up during the winter to eat. The same was done with apples + pears.

All the families knew each other from childhood all were unrelated, but had a special bond AND outsiders were not welcome. City people would often be curious about the hollow people but were greeted by men.

with guns. No outsiders were welcome

This is when they got the name Green Hollow Trash.

A lots of legends came out of the hills, passed on from Generations to Generations. Some were so far fetched one would wonder of the reality of them. but these things really happened.

Like Hannah, an 18 yr old who lived between the hollow + Bartlett 4 miles away, her parents were hollow people. Hannah had a child out of wedlock, the parents took the baby to the river where they drowned it.

Hannah died of a broken heart, her parents buried her in a corn field near by. later a headstone was erected in plattsburgh west, 4 miles away but Hannah was never in that grave. She still remains in the cornfield and hedgrou has it. She would walk the fields crying for her baby. And when it snowed her grave always melted it right away. later her remains were moved to an unknown cemetery, I believe it was Thurman, where my family is.

Then there was the story of a young couple engaged to marry. She suddenly took ill and died. Her funeral was at King Church, and was taken by buck board through the hollow to the Thurman cemetery. later that night the man went to dig her up to get his ring back. and discovered her fingers were bloody from digging the casket

She was alive AND clinging onto life.

He picked her up AND carried her through the Hollow, where women fainted, men yelled TAKE her back. She woke up AND they were married AND RAISED A Large Family.

AS years went by the Study children grew up AND STARTED leaving home to live married in Bartlett AND Surrounding Areas ALL near the Hollow. Bartlett was A town with Electricity Running water, a gas station that was ALSO A Grocery store AND A BAR. There was ALSO A School house.

Uncle John went to Wyoming with his bride, Never to return. He Raised several children AND passed away there.

My Aunt Elizabeth married A. Garith, Aunt AITA Never married. She lived at the mouth of the Hollow, all her life. She AND my dad were very close AND he watched over her. All AND ALL they all ended up together in the Thurman IA Cemetery.

My Grandpa was in her 50<sup>s</sup> when she had a stroke while hanging clothes on the clothesline. No one was around AND it started snowing. She Froze to death.

AFTER her death Grandpa's health went into a downward spiral. He checked himself into AN Old Soldier Home in Marshalltown, where he

passed away, AND IS Buried there as well.

Now Dad & Bill were the only ones left at the house. Dad was in his mid 20<sup>s</sup> when He joined the Army, this was around 1913. AND got caught up in WWI, in 1914 He served til 1916 He was given a medal for saving a man's life during combat this is when Dad took a Diamond Ring off a German AND Brought it home.

When returning home from the Army, uncle Bill had a wife, so the 3 of them shared the family home.

One winter morning my Aunt got up early to start the fire AND heat the house up. putting wood on the coals, then she threw Kerosene on the coals, the flame flashed out the door, catching her clothes on fire. Dad & Bill did everything to

save her but she was burned to badly. This is when Dad sold the diamond ring to pay for the funeral Bill moved out of the hollow AND never remarried.

Several year passed, without any records of Dad's life AND what he did for work, ect until 1926. when a corn farmer in Brownsville NEBRASKA needed help His name was Charles Reeves.

AND since my dad could drive a tractor AND knew a lot about farming He got hired. It was corn harvest MR Reeves was a tall slinky man 6" or more his wife Frances was a native American, shorts and a s, round as she was tall.

They had a large home with 4 children - 3

Girls, Mary, Rose and Dorothy, I saw Charles Jr.  
Little did anyone know that this chance  
encounter would end up being the beginning  
of a new study generation. Dad would marry  
Rose, my mother.

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Aunt Dorothy described Dad to me when they first met, she said he was tall 6'2" Coal Black HAIR AND Green Eyes, All the girls were smitten by him. But Rose caught his eye, altho she was 22 years younger. they connected and my mother got pregnant, mom was only 18, Dad was 40. I dont know the details of how her parents reacted but Dad took her home to Green Hollow and married her.

It must have been hard for her, since she was used to running water and electricity. But she loved him and his family welcomed her with open arms. A few months later their first child "Viola" was born, then a not long later a second child "Enid" came along. Their lives were changing fast. No time for each other, and no running around having fun. Dad had to work more jobs which took him away from her most the time. washing diapers by hand, warming water on the wood stove to wash them and bathe the girls. and still cooking and carrying wood, ironing, she must have been completely overwhelmed by it all.

Sometimes my parents would help her can food and watch the girls so she could have some free time, my uncle would take her to town, where they would stop to get a beer before returning home. my mom and uncle became close, too close

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She had A Bad crush on him.

Not Long AFTER A 3rd child came along, "Doris" Life was even worse, 3 children in 5 years. Dad starting staying away longer, sometimes for weeks. leaving her with little to no money for food. The family members helped with feeding her and the girls, buying clothes at the second hand store and visiting her for company Aunt Ina, Uncle Ezra's wife and Aunt Ethel Uncle Basins wife were always to her rescue.

Dad was furious, he said he could take care of his family and resented their help.

He told mom not to discuss their problems and refuse their help.

No one knew where dad was spending all his time, mom got lonely and being isolated made things worse. 3 crying children, hardly any food. Her life was hell. After all she was a young woman, still pretty and passionate and desirable. She wanted attention.

So she waited til dad was home and she walked 15 miles up the hollow to the man. To the bar. She had no problem finding men to buy her booze. Ending up in bed with them, being gone for days.

She had to go home, there was no other place

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To go. She had called her parents AND they told her to go home AND be a better wife. They didnt want A bunch of Kids there.

Dad started beating her, AND becoming demanding She wasnt Allowed To leave the House or spend time with Family. He came home every night AND demanded sex. She became more distant and fell out of love. She stayed for the girls only, wanting so bad to be free AND happy.

Then the worse happened, She was pregnant Again this time it was A Boy. Donald, he was a premature baby, AND it wasNT for certain he would live. She loved him more than the girls because he was so sickly. But he made it. Dad was beyond himself, he had A son. For some reason A MAN Always wants A son, it changes them. It did my dad, he became A better husband AND spent A lot of time at home to be with him. Life was better for mom, she now had A mate + help with the children. AND To top it off 3 yrs later she gave birth to Another Boy, "Lewis" Dad was in Seventh Heaven. But mom wasNT thrilled AT ALL. Don was the only one she wanted the rest of the kids werent AS special AS He was. Here she was 28 yrs old AND had 5 children.

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Dad was 50 year old now. He couldn't keep up the pace to bring in the money to feed his family. He taught the girls to steal eggs from the neighbors. He stole from things from people's sheds. He allowed men to sleep with my mom for money.

Including the town constable. But it backfired on him, my mom would get drunk with the men and didn't come home. Men would drive to the house looking for her, and dad ran them off. This went on for years she came home only when she wanted to and dad accepted that because he needed her to watch the kids. They fought all the time, he really loved her and didn't want to lose her, but it was too late. Mom would have men at the house when dad wasn't around and she drank a lot. Some of these men were my uncles, and neighbors. They bought her food and booze.

The oldest girls would tell dad what she did when he was gone, and the beatings started again. Then in '43 mom was pregnant again. Dad knew it wasn't his child and had her charged with adultery. She went to prison for a year in Iowa City Iowa where she gave birth to my

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Sister "ESTHER". When she FINISH Her Sentence She came home, the boys were thrilled to see her, but the girls had No part of her, or the baby. Dad let her stay because of the boys, he wanted ESTHER to go, but changed his mind when the father was revealed. My Uncle.

Sometime AFTER that my mother met Frank Drowell, a Soldier who lived in Talmage NEBR, he had a Blacksmith Shop and dated my mom, when dad wasnt around. My mother was pregnant Again, AND in 1/6 She had a baby girl "MARILYN". ME Dad didnt want me til he seen me, I was a mini him. I looked just like him, and still do. 3 weeks AFTER my birth mom left forever. She walked out on the boys AND ESTHER & I. The oldest girls were all grown up AND MARRIED AT the first MAN who came Along, just to get out of the horrible life they had at home.

Here dad was, Alone, Dan was Around 9 and Lewis 7. He couldnt keep us girls, so ESTHER AND I were given to a family in Bellevue NEBRASKA. Henry & Lotty Waite

ESTHER was 3, I was less than a year old.

# my life 6

AS A child naturally I dont remem here being a baby. I first memories were happy ones. my sister Esther was Always there unlike me she had memories of our old life.

The waites were sw there late 40's.

I recall them vividly, Henry was a tall man, with a full beard. Lottie was short had dark hair streaked in Grey

They had 3 children, Ruby who was married and had 2 boys. Then Russell and Bennett, They were both teenagers living at home.

LASH

We had a happy home, my best memories of life in this home still haunts me, oh how my life would have been so much better had I grown up there. 1.

The house sit on a large Acres, AFTER getting off the street you had to walk Aways to get to the house. The house was large inside, 4 bedroom bath, living room and large dining room and kitchen.

The outside was a large group of trees Extending a long ways. The back yard was one Giant Strawberry field, and the other side was trees ALSO.

Uncle Henry turned an old chicken coop into a playhouse where we would color and collect lightning bugs at night.

We had lots of chickens running around. Everytime I went near the rooster He would ATTACK

me. Aunt Lottie used the broom on him  
Uncle Henry worked for the railroad and  
Lottie, worked on a Gladys Farm behind  
our house during the flower season. She  
also picked strawberry and sold them.  
Russell + Everett helped pick them and wash  
them.

Weekends were special, we went to church  
and Ruby and her family came over for a  
large meal. She had a sow named Rodney  
that played games with Esther + I.

One time Ruby was making Jello, and  
the kids were hiding under the goat wood  
table, it had a table cloth so no one  
knew we were there. Suddenly I felt hot  
water on my head, I started screaming  
the bowl had broke and I was right below  
the section that connected the table.

The doctor came right away, put something on  
me, I have a small spot on the top of my  
head where hair doesn't grow now.

On Easter's we always got dresses + hats  
plus a giant egg hunt at church.

All holidays were a big event Christmas  
was special too, we took gifts to poor kids  
at church. I didn't want to give them away  
because I liked them. Aunt Lottie told

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me that was what Christmas was All About

Helping others who don't have what we do.

On July 4<sup>th</sup> Russell + Cverette Set fire works off, the day was full of Food, games, the men played cards the women gossiped and they all played horse shoes and drawk lemowade.

Every night we had to take a Bath, Lottie would check to see if we were clean, usually scrubbing the back of my ears til they hurt. I Swore when I grow up I'd never wash them and I don't

Every Afternoon, I had to take a Nap, I was the only child at home since the boys + Esther were in school. Lottie put me on her bed since it was closest to the living room where she could check on me. There was a Tall black cat statue on her dresser with Glass eyes, I was so Afraid of it, so she covered it up so I could sleep. I usually wasn't Sleepy, so I leaned if I covered up my head, then waited to be awake, the light made me look like I was Asleep. It worked

I was a busy little Bee when Noone was watching, I'd into Everetts Room and play with his Crayons, and Accedently break them.

When he came home, I could hear him yelling Mom, mARilyn was in my room Again

Aunt Lottie was doing the wash and I sat watching her, I was fascinated by how she put the clothes in the wringer, then she had to leave the room I recall her telling me not to go near the machine but I did, and I got my hand & arm caught in it, I thought it was going to eat me. I was screaming when Lottie popped the top to release me, the doctor came again, I was hurt bad but I never went near the machine again.

At dinner Lottie would get mad at me because I ate 1 thing at a time. She insisted I take bites of everything. Esther is the one who started scrambling my food together, I liked it then.

Russell would help Lottie with the ice box when the ice man came. He would chip the ice to fix the square where it belonged, there was ice chips all over the kitchen.

My favorite breakfast was Sugar Pops, it was on TV commercials, and on the package was a paper gun! I couldn't wait to have one of my brothers cut it out and put it together.

At night the boys + Esther with me, sat on the couch and watched The Cisco Kid. There was commercial about Buttered bread that the wrapper tore open and the bread was all sliced evenly. I thought that was neat cause buttered bread didn't look like that.

US kids Esther, Rodney + I all came down with the measles, we were put in a bedroom with blankets over the windows, AND rubbed down with Calamine Lotion AND socks on our hands. Tied on so we couldn't get them off. Later we got chicken pox But the windows weren't covered for this disease. I also had coughing cough. Its a wonder I survived all those

Once in a while Ruby + Lottie had us collect twigs for a fire to put perms in our hair. We didn't have a water heater. I had curls all over my head, but if I had a perm like that today I'd have a fit, it was frizzed. But Esther and I loved it.

Lottie taught us always to be ladies, with manners. She caught me dancing in the Strawberys. I pulled up my dress to swirl. She came out + spanked my rear. Ladies don't pull up there dresses. We always said Grace AND prayers, AND called

olders by there last name. MR or MRS  
Saying please + thank you to anything  
And never steal.

I learned the hard way you dont steal, Russel  
took me to the dime store with H.M. I saw  
A miniature harmonica and took it.

I showed it to Esther, and she told on  
me. Lottie took me to the dime store and  
tell the manager what I did. She payed for  
it and left it. I got a scolding and no  
playing outside or TV that night.

We were never spanked. or hurt in  
any way

On weekend after they graduated from school  
The boys would go to OMAHA, Esther + I Always  
look forward to seeing them come home.

We would sit on the porch and wait + wait  
then finally they appeared, handing us  
each a bag. Fresh BAKERY cookies + Bubble  
stuff. I was a ritual we always  
looked forward to.

The boys would hold us down + tickle  
us and let us use furniture to make  
houses covered with blankets. As long as  
we put everything back before Lottie  
and Wency returned.

After supper Henry would walk us girls

Now Esther was gone forever.

Everyone in the family stayed near me all the time so they wouldn't come back. I missed her so much. Crying myself to sleep, worried I'd never see her again.

Weeks later the family sat me down and told me they were coming back to get me, but I didn't have to go if I told them so. I didn't want to go.

When the day came Rose & her husband and Doris came to our house. Russell & Everett were there in case they tried to force me to go. I told them I wanted to stay with my family. Doris asked, "Don't you want to see Esther again?"

Yes, I said, well she lives with Rose and Frank and so would I if I went with them. I wanted my sister back. I loved her and we were never apart. So I said I'd go to be with her.

Aunt Lottie cried, as they took me away, never to see me again. It broke everyone's heart, and I often wonder if I'd stayed I would not endure the horrible life that awaited for me.

One single word "yes" destroyed my life.

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in the side yard to an old tree that was  
fallen and sit us down, He would peel  
an apple + share it with us and tell us a  
story. I cant recall any of them but this  
incident is embedded in my mind

A woman came to visit one time  
she had a little girl my age with her, Beverly  
was her name, we caught lightning bugs and  
I showed her my playhouse

Then more women started coming. Lottie  
said I was Rose Drewell, then Evid Lawson  
and Viola Garren. Then she sat us down  
and told us where we came from.

and they wanted us back. ESTHER + I  
said No, this is our home. we didnt know  
these people and we cried to stay.

When the day came to tell them we didnt want  
to go, Evid showed up. She parked away from  
the house and walked in foot to the house.

Esther + I were outside, when she came flying  
out of the house + grabbed my sister + drug  
her to her car, she tried to get me but I  
ran in the house, A man in the back seat  
was lying down not to be seen. He grabbed  
ESTHER + held her down + they drove off

Lottie called the law, but since there were  
no legal papers to keep us, nothing could be

I fell to sleep during the trip, and woke up when we stopped the car. I saw a house, it had 2 tunderas in the front & Roses growing on both sides of the door. I was down and looked old.

The front door opened and there was Esther, my was flying I couldn't wait to hug her, she had a big smile & her eyes were full of joy, she started crying & run to me. We must have embraced for 5 minutes, and she said she was so happy to see me, my god it was almost 2 years since we were together. She was 10 now I was 7. She had grown up now, dark brown hair, and here I had blonde. One couldn't tell we were sisters. She showed me our room, Esther explained who these people were. Rose was our real mom & Frank was our step father. That Original Dad (Bud) study was in Wyoming visiting his brother & he would be home soon. She explained that Lotte & Henry were our parents. I was so confused, I didn't know any of these people. I was afraid of them, Frank had a mean, fakes, and never smile, and the man who was watching Esther when they came to get me was Herman, Frank's Dad and Esther told him she explained Frank wasn't so nice to stay as far as possible way from him. My mind was over whelmed by all these people. I wanted Esther & I to go home.

The first day alone with Rose, she walked up down to the local grocery store, it was only 3 blocks, the whole town was only 8 blocks. The store was named Dammies. She introduced me and her baby daughter. The reason we went to the store was because Frank had given Rose money before he went to work to buy us girls one of the world's best Dammies sold. They were the size of Barbie dolls + beautiful dresses. I chose the one from Ireland, because I love Green.

That night Frank went out to his Blacksmith shop and fixed it up. It was a large ~~brick~~ building next to the main street. I recall Frank coming in the house and saying Lets show you the Shop.

I was walking then I heard the noise, it was a roar with loud noises coming from inside. I never heard anything like it, I was scared + started to run back to the house. When Frank grabbed me + picked me up + continued to the shop. I was screaming + kicking and he was laughing + so was Rose. I just knew I was going to get killed I was so afraid. When we got inside there were machines with belts + a large pit with fire and a giant tub of water, it smelled horrible.

inside. Esther told me it was ok, no one was going to hurt me that Frank made things with the fix for people & get money for them. That Experience has stayed with me all my life. I've never known real fear til then. I hadnt experienced Fear before.

meal time was strange, there were things we was gals weent allowed to eat, jello, fruits or milk.

That was for Frank only. I couldnt understand it.

Esther told me he would get drunk & when he does Ride, but usually drank in his shop with some food of his named jelling.

Devis & her husband lived about 3 blocks away. Harlan was his name, they had a only girl. Carol Jean. Devis was always at our house. she liked Frank and I found why one day when Esther + I were told to wash the car & stay out of the house.

I went in for some reason & heard the strangest sounds coming from rooms in bedrooms. There was a hole in the wall so I looked in. Devis was on the edge of the bed with no pants on and Frank was screwing her, Mom was sitting watching them with a smile on her face. I couldnt believe it, when I told Esther she said it happens all the time. Not to let them know I seen them.

Eshe said our real dad was really nice and lived not that far away, that he would be home soon.

and that he knew we were happy and didn't want to take us  
 was and he didn't want to give us up but he  
 was alone & couldn't care for us. That he ~~knew~~  
 we were happy at Lotties and wanted no part of  
 stealing us. He said we were better off there.

In the days I would roam all over town  
 I met a little girl with a playhouse in the  
 back yard. We played for days on end and  
 Mom didn't care she was busy with making  
 wax roses for her yard or drinking with Frank.

at night Esther & I would lay in bed & make  
 animals on the wall with our hands using the  
 shadows of the lamp in our room.

Mom would come into our room with a  
 sheet over her to ~~scare~~ <sup>scare</sup> us, but we would  
 laugh because we knew who she was, and  
 Frank would be in the next room talking like  
 she was in the room with him.

I didn't really care for the school I went to.  
 at recess the janitor would push me on the swing  
 and pinch my rear every push. He tried to get  
 me to help him put lockers & my away, but  
 I didn't like him so I refused. Now I realize  
 he was a pedophile.

The town had yearly Purple & white days  
 They had a parade & threw Candy off floats  
 We always looked forward to these days.

Behind our house was a giant Dance Hall for the U.F.W. a lot of Saturday night they would have big parties that went on to midnight. Esther & I would get up early to go look for beer bottles which were worth 2d each. Sometimes we found money too.

Mom had gotten us peggy banks of Aunt Jamina we didn't take long to fill them. Trying to buy something special. One day we had all went on a ride in Frank Stadelacker and when we got back some one Banks were gone. Only 1 person had a key to the house, Doris. nothing was ever said to her. We were heart broken and started keeping our money in a jar we put in the Shop, Frank didn't even know it was there.

Frank would become physical with mom when they got "down" & hitting her & shoving her down calling her names. we stayed in our bed hugging each other I wanted to help her but sis said not to leave our room he would come after us. I never experienced fear before, not by a person I just cried my eyes out. what if he came after us. where would we go,

I tried to spend as much time as I could outside when Frank was home, when I had to go inside I spent time in the bathroom. Some week ends Frank would take us to a town called otoc to a bar, where

the men would spend hours drinking. They would give us pay money, we would walk around the main street, we didn't get anything to eat & sometimes it was early morning before we left. They would fight on the way home & Esther & I fell to sleep. When we got home Esther would wait til they passed out & go get us something to eat.

Then Frank's wrath turned on us, if he didn't like a little thing we did we never got any food. Sometimes he slapped my sister so hard she fell on the floor.

One time (it was a weekend) my friend across the street from us had an Uncle who on leave from the military he got his motorcycle out & was giving all the kids rides up & down the main street. Esther wasn't there, I got to go on a ride, on the way back I saw Frank in front of his shop drinking with a friend. I was afraid he ~~seen~~ me, I was afraid to go home. When I did he & mom sat me down & said So you want to get fucked, well we will and they pulled me & held me down took off my pants & Frank held me up in the air while mom put Red pepper in my uterus, the entire time, I burnt so bad I was screaming I thought I would die, I ran to Doug's house.

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and she ~~seen~~ I was in pain & what it was causing it, she put me in the tub & helped wash it away then she took me to the hospital in New City, where they flushed me out with something. There was no child protection agency back then so the hospital didn't report it.

I hated ~~hate~~ ~~now~~ ~~now~~ along with being afraid of them, and the one thing that came out to this ordeal is I couldn't scream anymore and to this day I cannot scream.

Then one night, it was winter, the pot belly stove was going and they got into a big fight, this time Frank held Mom against the hot stove, she was screaming and we ran out the door to Dad's house. She called the Law, and loaded us girls up & took us to plattsmouth where my sister Viola lived with her family. We slept there and come morning after eating she took us to our Dad's in "Green Hollow". The torture and fear was finally over.

It was mid morning, when we arrived, and I was somewhat afraid, I'd never met my dad before but Esther had, she was excited and told me we had 2 brothers living with Dad. ~~Don's~~ Lewis, Don was around 17 Lewis was 14.

When we pulled up to the mouth of the hollow

I couldn't believe my eyes. Trees, lots of trees  
 then hills. Tall hills with a small road that  
 had trees growing out over the road, there was  
 a deep ditch with water & tall hills over the  
 other side, I loved it, it was like a  
 paradise.

When we arrived at the house, no one was  
 outside, it was still early morning. The first  
 thing I saw was squirrels running & jumping from  
 tree to tree, the birds were singing and the  
 wind was still, it was spring time and so  
 exciting for Esther & I. Uncle went in & everyone  
 was just getting up & Louis & Don were still asleep,  
 but I could see them. Dad was drinking coffee &  
 in the kitchen & I couldn't believe how old he looked.  
 Tall with white hair and tall & lanky. I was so  
 happy to meet him - but my happiness was soon crushed  
 when Rose came out of the bedroom, she had bandages  
 on her arm. I expected to see Frank but learned  
 he was in jail. I wanted her to leave. All we knew now  
 was fear and unhappiness with her. I just hoped  
 I had found a new life with my dad's. And I was  
 thrilled when my dad told my mom she couldn't  
 have us back until she straightened out her life.

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Viola left ~~at~~ dinner or so and Dad said he would take  
 Mom home to Big this time Lewis + Esther were  
 sitting and talking when Dad wanted me to sit on his  
 lap. He said he was so happy I was home with  
 him. This is the first time since I left ~~home~~  
 that anyone held me on their lap + actually wanted  
 me around. My life lit up, I have a real dad  
 that really loved me and wanted me with him.  
 Dad also assured me, Mom would never get me  
 back now. He was really upset at what we  
 had told him about the things that we ~~experienced~~  
 at  
 Mom's.

Life was good, Esther + I would play in the  
 yard and Lewis had a hobby of catching mice in  
 a jar at night, we had lots of them, so we would  
 wait as he put strings around the top of the jar  
 + put food inside, we didn't have electricity so we  
 used lanterns + table lamp. We sat in the slightly dark  
 rooms + wait, it was so much fun.

We had an outhouse, but had a potty for use at  
 night, the house smelt like clean air, no  
 cigarettes like Mom's, and there was no alcohol smell.

We had a cellar built into the hill across from  
 our house, we kept milk + meat + canned goods  
 in there, we had to only buy for a week because  
 the meat + milk went bad in the summer but  
 until we stopped ~~buying~~

Every Saturday we all got into dad's pickup + go to Plattsmouth to shop, Esther + I rode in the back; it was so much fun. We stayed in the pickup while dad + Lewis shopped. When it rained Dad put a wide board across the back + put a tarp on it for shelter from the groceries. We always got a roll of life savers on shopping day. Saturdays were special we always looked forward to it.

For breakfast we ate cereal, sometimes Egg and Bacon, and Dad always had to have winter onions on his food, supper was fried potatoes and squirrel I never had squirrel before but it was yummy. After supper Lewis did the dishes and Esther + I would sit outside with Dad, we asked him questions and he asked us questions. He would tell us about his childhood and his brothers. Sometimes he talked about mom but not very often. He always told me when mom + Frank met "Two fools well matched". He told us the reason we went to live with Satie was because we were so small and he couldn't work with no one to watch us, and he knew the Whites were good people.

We used to get into the pickup + go to church a lot, Dad knew everyone there, after services we would run + play with the other families kids. Lewis was about 14 now and we had

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been at Dads a year or so, usually someone would bring chicken and squirrel and Lemons for the kids after the pastor left it was best time for the men. We would be there for hours. Back behind the church were the stact of the hills and cut trees were lying on the ground, the men would use the large pieces for chairs and the stump for a table + play paper children were not allowed up there.

Sometimes on Saturday we went to visit my sister Gail in plattmouth nebraska her nickname was Jean. Her husband was Edmar, they had 2 kids April + Mike. April was a little younger than me she was around 5 and Mike was about 3. Jean had a big house in the country with a big yard, she had a large garden and I really liked her.

Sometimes we would spend the night and I liked that because I got to see TV. my favorite was Gunsmoke. I felt ignored most the time but I was used to it at home Lewis + Don would argue a lot when dad was gone. which was a lot.

Anyway Jean would bring friends over with kids my age but I wasn't allowed to go out and play with them, she kept me hidden in the upstairs bedroom. I didn't understand why so I would sit by the window + watch them play. Dad would come up + go to bed early and I spent my night listening to him snore until I fell to sleep.

On Sundays Jean would use some special shampoo to make Dad's hair gleaming white he always looked forward to that. Then we would go back to the hollow where the boys were + Esther. Jean I don't like Esther so she wasn't allowed at her house.

The Sidney Rodeo came to town + Dad got a job working there, he helped to get the monkeys from their <sup>cage</sup> cage + back after their show. Esther + I + Lew had a blast at the Rodeo, since Dad worked there we all got free rides. We had no money so we didn't get soda or treats but it didn't matter we were having fun. After closing we would all go home only to return the next day.

Lew + Esther + I would go to the creek and walk in it + splash each other, it wasn't deep but we took soap + cleaned up the best we knew. One time I stepped on a broken fruit jar and cut my heel half off; Lew carried me home and Dad washed it and put alcohol on it. I needed stitches but I never got them I don't know why. I was told not to walk on it, and Esther helped me hop around. We wrapped it in old clothes + waited for it to heal. I missed out on going fishing and playing for a long time

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W.Dad + Don would argue, a lot, even yelling at each other, Don was around 19 then and he would steal from Dad's sell his things for money. Don always took Dad's truck without permission, which was easy to do when it rained because the road to our house was dirt + it turned to mud so Dad parked at the mouth of the hollow + walk home. probably 1/2 mile, Don would get up + walk to the pickup + go running around. using up all the gas.

Our school was in Bertlett Iowa, it was 3 stories tall made of Brick. A school bus would pick us up at the end of the hollow and bring us home. We had to get up early to eat, check our traps and walk to the bus. The three of us would race home to get strawberries that were ripe and apples and pears. Lewis would shoot squirrel and Esther + I would carry wood to cook with. In the winter we ran because we were cold and Dad wasn't home if he didn't show up when we arrived.

In school we were the only Green Hollow kids kids made fun of us because we were poor and our dad was so old. We never had home work that was an invention of modern times. We were taught square DANCING, soft ball, Art, penmanship and math. when it was cold we played basket ball and music. And all we needed for school supplies were Big Chief TABLETS

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21 33  
and 2 lead pencils and crayons.

On holidays we had Easter parties, Halloween parties & Christmas parties. We always made decorations for all them. At Easter we were suppose to bring 2 boiled decorated eggs. but we never had any extra and we could afford colouring. so our teachers would do it for us.

Christmas parties were my favourite especially one year we had a party for the parents, my teacher made me an outfit so I could be Suzie Snowflake. I was amazed that dad brought Don, Lewis & Esther to see me dance. I was so happy, we got cup cakes & pencils with our name on them and fancy paper napkins with Santa on them. We didn't have Christmas at our house; we had no money for tree decorations or presents so we just stayed home & kept warm. We had no toys so we helped Dad cut wood and unload it.

When the winter set in Dad moved us to a dugout house. Its where he had dug into a hill and built a large room with wood and covered it with aluminium then dirt. we had 4 beds a stove for heat & cooking stove and a table to eat on with chairs there was 1 window. We had to climb a steep hill to get up there but dad ran a rope from the pine tree out front to the

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Bottom so we could get up + down our outhouse wasn't very far + neither was the cellar, but we had to carry wood up that hill, so when it was nice out we would make big piles for later.

The snow really got deep those winters, we wore snow pants + black snow boots that had 14 or so buckles. Their pants were made out of weather proof material that was poly-filled, they had suspenders + went over your shoulders. Snow shoes were made of rubber, they fit over your regular shoes + buckled up kinda like combat boots only they had hooks that snapped together, they came up to the middle of your leg. Girls had to wear dresses only to school. So the pants + shoes kept you warm.

Our school had a field trip, we went to Shavanoak and were suppose to bring money for lunch + Roller skating. Dad got us 20¢ each, but it only paid for lunch + we had enough for 1 set of skates, so we took turns on them. We went to a dime store but didn't anything to spend, Lewis stole a baby turtle for us and some candy. Dad never knew about it and we weren't going to tell.

Dad + Don got into a fight + Dad kicked him out, he was a thief and stole from Dad + our Uncle. He went to live with Jean and she got him a job. He bought a car and nice clothes. We went to see him and visit Jean for the weekends.

One time I had a bad tooth ache, my teeth were rotten from no proper food or brushing. No one cared I hurt, I was crying cause of the pain. Then Dad came home + brought me some Red Cross toothache medicine, It was so much better then.

In my 19<sup>th</sup> year my world came to an end again. Dad said we were going back to Moms again. I cried + Esther told him we hated him because he had promised us we never had to return there but he never said why, he just loaded us up and took us to Moms. But now she lived in Nebraska City by a park + my Aunt Dorothy lived 2 blocks away. Frank was working for Ocoma foods where they killed turkey + chickens + made TV Dinners. He cleaned up the heads feet + feathers.

Dad said he would come see us on weekends, but that was just another promise he broke. I loved my dad + couldn't figure out what I did wrong to have to leave his home. Esther + I were so scared we just knew our happy days were over. And we would miss Lew + Dad.

## A New Chapter in Life

Esther + I were really scared to go our moms we knew what they were capable of doing.

They lived in a house with 3 Room Kitchen, Living room + 1 bedroom, we had a Roll Away Bed to Sleep in the Living room. It was tiny. Outside there were about 16 plum trees, and an apple orchard and cherry trees. They lived on a hill that one had to climb about 15 steps up to get to the house. What I liked best was we lived next door to a park no one ever came there because it was an old one, it was full of black walnut trees.

My Aunt Dorothy and her husband Ocie lived down the hill from us. Next to the Missouri River.

You could see it clearly from moms house

My Aunt had 3 kids living at home Eddie a teenager Chris a little younger than I and Bobby, he was in his 30's. Their house was a shack, because they were poor, it reminded you of a cardboard house, with junk all over the yard.

Mom + Frank seemed to slow down on their drinking except week ends. Frank worked at Ocoma Foods with Doris and Mom just visited her sister or sat a smoked all the time.

At first Frank was nice to us but it didn't take long for him to start in on us, by telling us how bad our dad was and how

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Lucky we were that he let mom have us. When ever his TV stations werent coming in good he accused us of messing with the knobs, but we never touched it. And we wouldnt get to watch it as punishment.

I spent most of my days at Aunt Dorothy's house. Chris + I had stick horses and we ran all over the yard + park. Eddie had to carry water from the park to their house because it had no running water. Uncle Ocie did mostly paint jobs and any other job he could to support the family. They always had plenty of food + had large gathering of family.

I missed my dad + Lewis really bad, Esther and I were always afraid to be in the house when Frank was there. The house was so small + he was always in the living room where our bed was. You could tell he didnt want us there, always complaining about us, or yelling at us.

Uncle Ocie would come honking his horn on the car and yell for us girls to come down to his house, it would be 9 pm and we had to go to bed. But he got us up and went to his house for ice cream. We usually spent the

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night because they knew how we had to live.

Uncle Ocie would take Esther down to the river and teach her to swim, I sat fishing with Eddie & Chris. It was so much fun to go to my Aunt & uncles.

On the 4<sup>th</sup> of July, they had a big picnic at the new park, Uncle Ocie would go at 3 AM & put 4 or 5 tables together and they were filled with food. My Dad was suppose to show up but he never did, I kept watching for him, hoping to see him but I was left in dispare. The picnic was fun, lots of kids to play with and fireworks, then Mom & Frank showed up they made us go home before the fireworks I just felt so bad, no Dad, no fireworks. Doesn't anyone care? Frank and Mom were drunk. Esther refused to go home, she stayed with Aunt Dorothy. I don't think she was going to put up with it anymore because soon after she moved out of Mom's and went to live with Aunt Dorothy.

I hated being alone, walking to school alone and it was about a good 1 1/2 walk to get there, I met a classmate Becky Yost who lived with her Aunt & Uncle because

her dad Beat her mother to death, when she was small, her Aunt took her to school AND sometimes I got to ride with them.

I used to walk the alleys downtown going through the trash of the Dept Stores, I found all kinds of good stuff I never got home before dark, AND I WASNT MISSED, NO ONE SAID ANYTHING TO ME ABOUT BEING SO LATE.

We had a neighbor just up the hill behind our house who was a hired man to take care of our handfords Apple + peach Orchard. His name was EARL; he liked me to come visit AND I LOVED LISTENING TO HIM WHISLE, HE SOUNDED LIKE A BIRD AND I ENJOYED IT, I WENT THERE TO GET AWAY.

Then one day EARL AND FRANK went Goose Berry hunting along the river, they took them to EARL AND put them in a Big Crock pot type container to make wine FRANK went up there every night to stir it. Anyway they had lots of jars of wine AND FRANK really drank a lot.

One day Dad showed up with Lewis to visit AND get Esther from my Aunts I was so happy to see them. Lewis

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Tell me Don had joined the Army AND Dad was so proud. He was coming home to visit AFTER BASIC training. Dad started drinking FRANKS wine AND was really drunk; he AND FRANK got into AN ARGUMENT AND FRANK tried to push him down the concrete steps (16) in the front yard, Lewis held him upwards to STOP his FALL. I was so scared, Dad told FRANK IF you ever hurt my kids I will Kill you, AND Lewis drive them home to Iowa with Esther. I wanted to go, but I wasn't ASKED or told.

I LAID in Bed at night AND cried, Everyone had deserted me AND NOW I HAD figure out A WAY to get out of MOMS. I Lay in Bed listening to them having sex in the next room, the bed squeaked AND BOUNCED, it was DISGUSTING Night after Night.

One day I didn't want to go to School I told mom my Stomach hurt Real Bad. Before I knew it Dad was there to take me to the Doctor, SINCE Dad was a WWI Vet he got ALL his childrens medical Free. When the doctor started poking my Belly I knew I better tell him it hurt or Dad would Really be mad, so when he poked my

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right side I said that's where the pain  
was. He called my dad in and said well  
'Bud' dad's nickname, look like we need  
to remove her Appendix. When I asked  
what that meant Dad said they have to  
cut you open. OH NO I thought, I'm only  
10 years old, I can't do that. They put  
me in the hospital + Dad brought me some  
Baby Doll pjs, They were Esthers, back then  
Baby Doll pjs were the hot thing to own  
I was a little jealous that Esthers had  
them + I slept in an old night t shirt.  
When they took me to surgery I was  
really scared, but when they put a mask  
over my face it had stinky stuff coming  
out (either) I fought it but was sound  
asleep in no time. When I woke up  
my belly was wrapped in gauze completely  
and I hurt badly. I was so sorry I lied  
but I had to keep it to myself. Dad  
never knew the truth ever.

I had fun eating ice cream and Sherbert  
and someone brought me paper dolls. I always  
had paper dolls from the Sears Catalog but  
these were real ones with out fits

But the fun would soon end when  
I was sent home. Dad took me back to

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Moms Again, Even tho I begged him not to. That was the last time I saw him. I had turned 11 in March and the day AFTER Thanksgiving my Cousin Eddie came running up to our house and said Uncle Bud was Dead, and my older sisters were on their way to get me.

Dad had been plowing the road to his house and went over into the ditch and lay there all night; his Spleen was Broken and he layed & Froze to Death.

Lewis & Esther were at Jews house waiting for Dad, so when he never showed up they all went looking for him. The road was caved in where they found him & the tractor was on top of him. They all were screaming crying just AS I was. Later,

They had to order a special coffin for him, back then anyone over 5'8" was considered a Giant. Dad was 6'2". Don came home from the Army. I had never seen a Dead person before, let alone the one person I loved more than anything. I kept thinking he was just ASleep and told him to wake up. Don said sis he cant wake hes ASleep forever. Then I cried I wanted him BACK.

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The funeral was at Kings Church  
The place was jammed, some stood outside. I sat with Don & he held my hand, he said dont worry ses I will be there when you need me.

I recall the smell of roses that were draped over the casket, to this day I hate roses because of that, then we all went to the Thurman grave yard where the military shot of guns & someone played Taps on top of the hill. I didnt cry, I held it in, Mom & Frank were there and my oldest sister Viola got the flag that was on the casket. then we all went back to Dads house in the bottom where Jean Viola & Esther got into a fist fight over Dads flag. Jean was on top Viola, Esther was on top Jean. Jeans husband was going to help her when Don stepped in & stepped him Lewis & I just watched, we couldnt believe them acting like that. Frank & mom were there when Frank spoke up & told them that was no way to act after they just buried their Dad. So they kicked him out of the house soon after Viola took us back to our house in

NEBRASKA CITY.

Lewis want to live with Jean and Esther  
 went to Viola's to live. Don deserted the  
 Army and lived in Dad's House until they  
 found him and put in prison in Ft Leavenworth  
 KANSAS for Desertion.

A while later Jean contacted mom + said  
 they were going to visit Don + she could  
 come along. I recall her arriving at our  
 house with Esther in the back seat all  
 beat up + bleeding. Jean dragged her out of the  
 car onto the gravel road + told her to die.

I ran to get Uncle Ocie to help her and  
 we almost didn't get to go because of Frank.  
 Jean didn't want him around. We had to listen  
 to his bitching + aches + pains all the way  
 down + all the way back. No one liked him  
 but it was good to see Don. And see he  
 was healthy. We ran into a blizzard on  
 the way home + spent the night creeping  
 along the roadway. I fell to sleep.

Next day I checked on Esther and she was  
 OK, but never came home. She went back to  
 Viola's. How she + Jean were together I will  
 never know.

There was a family down the road from us  
 that were known for trouble, they had a boy

About 13. named Paul that was Always hanging Around Uncle Ocie's + He AND ANOTHER boy.

Valentine Smith pushed AN old CAR top into the River + IT SANK. VALENTINE WAS DROWN. There were hours before they found him. His FATHER Found him knee deep mud. Everyone said Paul killed him because there was NO water in his lungs. Frank + mom had the mom + dad at the house before the body was found offering them Whiskey + coffee AND Coffee. Frank was DRUNK MAKING AN ASS OF HIMSELF. IN the process mr

Smith had left behind his hat at our house. I know where they lived so AFTER A few days I WAS on my way to return it AND this dog came running at me. He had a hold of my leg biting into it.

The owner came out + Stopped. When I cried + cried All the way home. Mom went to my Aunt AND called the police. The Sheriff took us to the hospital AND they told him to go quarantine the dog. I had stitches AND was told I needed Rabies shots. To be safe.

The dog died, he had rabies, AND I had A Shot Every day For 5 days AND my belly the needles were long AND they HURT. I got teased A lot At school, the kids

would say Run She's got Rabies.

I was Always the class clown, I got a lot of hours sitting in the hall for talking during class. But making the other kids laugh was my only happiness I had. One day about 1/2 hour before the class was dismissed for the day the teacher announced that she was going to leave the room and I could have the class to tell jokes til the bell rang I had everyone laughing all the time. I felt so full of happiness and the kids asked if I could do that again. She said "NO" so I did it during class and spent more time in the hall.

One day I was at the park, just trying to stay away from the house when Jim Cheney Paul's older brother, the one connected to the drowning well Jim was about 18, here I was 13, he grabbed me and threw me to the ground, said to take off my pants he was going to fuck me. I tried to run, I couldn't scream I was so scared. Then I heard a voice say leave her alone Jim, it was my cousin Eddie getting water. I never played in the park again.

I just seemed like something happened all the time and I didn't have Esther

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To protect me anymore.

At school we were given plastic flutes for music and a book on the notes system to play, I would get up early and sit on the front steps and play my flute and watch the barges go down the river, I often wondered where they were going & wanted to be on one. Sometimes on the weekends I would watch people ride horses down by the river, I wondered how much fun it would be to have fun like that.

Mom had a small dog named Tricksey she was kept in the bathroom all the time chained to the stool, I wanted to walk her but Frank said "No" stay away from her. I used to sit on the stool and pet her, I could see in her eyes she hurt as bad as I did. I gave her water because no one else did.

One day she disappeared, I was told she got loose and ran away. Fact is she died and they put her body down the sewer opening outside the house, mom said she was still alive when they did it, but dying. I cried a lot over that, I wondered if they could do that to me

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I Felt helpless, AND Alone, That poor helpless dog lived like I did. Alone, NO ONE WHO LOVED

me, DAD, ESTHER, LEWIS & DAN WERE ALL GONE

I WAS ALONE IN THE WORLD, AND I LIVED WITH 2 PEOPLE I HATED! AND WERE AFRAID OF.

I WENT TO AUNT DOROTHY CRYING, I TOLD HER I WANTED TO DIE, JUST LIKE TRICKSY I WAS GOING TO DIE, IF I NEVER GOT AWAY FROM MOM & FRAWK. I ASKED HER TO HELP ME

AND SHE DID!

## Another Chapter of life Jean

A few days later Jean showed up, telling mom she wanted to take me for a visit at her house. I'm sure it wasn't a hard decision to make. I was just a burden to her anyway.

I didn't have to pack, my belongings all fit in a box, I had lived like that for years. I didn't even own a toothbrush.

The fear of being put down the sewer was gone, I was finally free from them.

Jean called an attorney and got legal custody of me, I was 13, I don't remember birthday parties or gifts. No one ever had 1 for me. I had been to other people's parties but I never got one.

Jean lived in Nehawka NEBR. in a 2 story house. I liked her & Delmar (her husband).

She put me in school and took me to the goodwill for clothes and shoes. April was snow and mile 6. Jean told me she received money from dad's SSN til I was 18 so she bought me the things I needed & never had before. Toothbrush, shoes etc. I didn't know how to act having so many clothes. I even got baby doll pants and barretts for my hair. I felt good knowing Dad was helping me get things from the grave.

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Delmar worked at a chemical plant in  
 Plattsmouth he had a few miles to drive back and  
 forth, and Jean worked but was still working  
 to have a baby a few months ago so she had  
 Lewis watch the kids so she could return to  
 work at American material in Neosho city I helped  
 with April + Mike while he watched over Barbara  
 the baby. I had friends at Schobell who  
 all went bike riding, but I didn't have a bike  
 but it sure looked like fun, they would  
 ride over to my house to visit, I rode one  
 of the bikes, it was easy to learn. Oh how  
 I wanted one

Sometimes on weekends we would all go to  
 Omaha, to Goodwills, yard sales and drive-in parks  
 we went to playland park, an amusement park  
 open the summer months I got to go on Big People  
 Rides, it was lots of fun

Lewis found me a newspaper job, the Lincoln  
 Star, I got a silver dollar for every new  
 customer I got lots of new ones and  
 I was saving for playland park + yard  
 sales, ice cream bars after school etc  
 and then Jean said since April + Mike  
 following me on my route I had to pay them  
 I did all the work, I carried the papers, collected  
 money I didn't need them following me

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to deliver papers I was mad so I quit my job  
I did the work, I collected money and I didn't  
need them taking my money.

Seemed Jeaw was coming home later + later everyday  
She rode to work with a friend of hers named  
Ed Roddy, he & his wife Carol had 2 girls and lived  
in the same town. Ed would bring Jeaw home and  
sit and drink beer with her & Delmar. He was  
always drunk.

Sometimes Delmar would start going to poker  
parties after work, so now both of them was  
gone a lot of the time, both coming home  
drunk, and then they started fighting, not  
just yelling, Jeaw would use a knife on him  
and kick him around, he never defeated himself  
either. I just hid, I had seen this too  
many times before, and again I was scared  
for them to come home.

One day Jeaw was home and Barbara went into  
a seizure, her eyes rolled up into her head & she  
was screaming, Lewis & she took her to children's  
hospital in Omaha, where they discovered a tumor  
in her brain, they operated & she took a long  
time before she could come home. After she returned  
her hair fell out and now she was Jeaw's favorite  
Mike and April were put on the back shelf for  
attention. Lewis & I would play hide & seek with

Them, AND give them A lot of Attention  
 We didnt go places anymore, Always home  
 while Jean & Delmar did their Separate things  
 I guess you could say Lewis was Dad & I was  
 Mom.

One night Delmar came home drunk and told  
 me to go get something out of his Trunk.  
 I opened it AND there was A Bicycle in it  
 He won it in a poker Game AND gave it to  
 me. Well Jean wanted April to have it, but  
 it was too tall for her. Delmar said it was  
 mine AND the fight began, She kicked him  
 in the mouth AND his teeth went through  
 his chin. He had to go to hospital to  
 get stitches Lewis took him.

I never touched the bicycle, it sat in the  
 garage for months. It seemed everything was  
 Aprils, I didnt like her she told her mom every  
 move + Always getting me into trouble. Jean  
 would yell at me for the dumbest reasons, She told  
 me I was 13 and old enough to do dishes, laundry  
 AND feed the kids I wanted to play with  
 Friends AFTER School but I didnt get to. Not  
 even on weekends.

Then the Big Blowup came, Delmar accused  
 her of cheating on him with Ed, I guess  
 Eds wife called him + said Ed wasnt coming.

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home either. Jean beat him up and he said he was taking the kids and leaving her. He and Ed got into a fist fight right there in the front yard. Ed told Jean it was over that he wasn't going to break up the family. Jean was so mad she decided to move to the country just outside plattsmouth where Virginia lived. The house had 2 Bedrooms, living room, dining room & kitchen. It had a coal furnace in the basement that also took wood. A very big yard and an old shed made of bricks in the back. The owners owned a Dairy Farm and our house was fenced in so the cows couldn't escape or come in our yard.

One day Don shows up at Jean's, he was out of prison and needed a place to live. So now Don & I lived with her, Louis stayed in Nelwaka with a guy named Al Dosi that he worked for, but later moved to Plattsmouth and took Louis with him.

Jean introduced Don to a gal she used to work with Joyce ese, tee is how you pronounce it. Joyce came from a well to do family who owned a Grocery store in a small town near by. Don was always going with her, and I used to wash his car for 50¢ every Saturday.

Soon after they were married & had a baby on the way. Don moved her down the road from us in a farm house.

Jean & Delmar would go to the horse races in Omaha on weekends, leaving me to babysit. Don would be with them and they never returned before 10 at night. Leaving me

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to cook 3 meals, clean house AND watch 3 kids, I'm 13 I can hardly keep up with it ALL I wish Lewis was still there, he was 19 now AND I could use the help. They never ever brought home any left over I love Catfish and they ate at Joe Tessa's CATFISH house in Omaha.

Sometimes they went bowling, sometimes to wrestling matches and always I was stuck with the Brats. They never took us anywhere FUN, just to Viola's where the same old CRAP went on. Viola had a daughter Beverly who was 1 month younger than me. She was like April, she had everything, a howdy dandy Doll, canopy Bed, Bicycle, Skates. Jean used to compare me to her. Beverly knows this & that AND can put rollers in her hair, know how

To peel potatoes the right way, well I thought IF I had been raised by a mother I would know these things too.

One time I really made Bev mad when I told her I sleep with April not a Dummy, which howdy Duddy was. She cried to her mom Jean thought it was funny. Esther had been living there but she went to our uncle John's house in Sheridan Wyoming for ~~an~~ a while, she was 16 now AND old enough to travel on a Bus Alone. I couldn't wait for her to return.

One day out of nowhere Ed roddy showed up, he was drinking as usual AND Jean told me they were going for a ride, that ride lasted til just before Delmar got home around 7. April + I were told to not say a word to him AND we didnt.

Jean planted a Big Garden. It was huge, about 1/2 block long + wide, there were tomatoes, potatoes, carrots ONIONS Cucumber, PEPPERS you name it we had it. I was given the job of hoeing it ALL AFTER school + week ends.

 cows. It ALSO had A Bull, in with them  
 We had chickens running ALL over AND they  
 would lay Eggs in that Barn. I had to  
 watch for the bull AND run real fast to  
 get the Eggs. AND That bull seemed to  
 know I was there so here he came. I got  
 up in the top of the hay to get Away.  
 Sometimes it was AN hour before he left.  
 Everyone was laughing at me, but I got  
 the eggs.

It wasn't long before I had to skew chicken  
 for meals. AND that was Gross, I could Not  
 Eat them. I ALSO had to dig potatoes for  
 meals, there were 6 of us so I had to have  
 A lot, some plants had A lot, but other didnt  
 AND it got hot AND cold out, AND I had  
 to wash them, peel them + slice them.

Jean would swim in the Summer AND  
 I had to peel the tomatoes, AND pick Green

Beans & clean them. I was Always  
 Tired. As A reward I got to watch  
 Sci Fi movies on Saturday nights.  
 I never got to go anywhere, I had  
 to watch the kids All the time  
 plus clean, cook hoe the garden And  
 laundry. I felt like A Slave,  
 Jean would TAKE off (She said to  
 the horse races) during the day And  
 wanted Everything done So Delmar couldn't  
 tell she was gone, she was Actually  
 with Ed Roddye. ~~One day Ed Roddye~~  
 In One night Delmar brings home a large  
 bottle of whiskey, A gift from one of the  
 guys at work, it WAS near Xmas time  
 And some gave gifts. It sat in the fridge  
 for a long time since ~~no one~~ drank whiskey  
 at our house. We were going to go to  
 Delmar parent in Missouri for Xmas And  
 A few days before we left Ed showed  
 up, I seen him take it out ~~it~~  
 And Took A Big Swallow putting it back  
 in the back of Everything before they left  
 Just the night before we were to leave  
 Delmar noticed it open. He Asked Jean who  
 opened it, she said it must have been  
 Marilyn, He was really mad, he said well

Let's let her have it All AND made me sit at the Table AND Drink it til I passed out, I woke up AND I had peed my pants, I was on the kitchen floor soaked w/ whiskey & pee. I crawled to my bed but couldn't get up w/ it so I slept on the floor. Early next day they wanted to leave I couldn't walk, Delmar drug me to the car & put me in the back seat. I was so thirsty for water but didn't have any. I could hear them eating chips and snacks but I could see anything, my head was spinning, I woke up at Delmars Mom, she was a nurse. When they told her what happened she gave me something to help me. She was all upset because as she said Marilyn could die from this. She put me to bed AND Fed me, the next day I was better, but it took 2 days to come out of it.

Delmars Sister Donna was there, she owned a Prime Store, she had gifts for everyone AND even me. I got new slacks, shirts AND panties. which Jean took from me for April, even tho they never fit her.

I told Jean I was going to tell Delmar about Ed being there AND she threw me up against the wall AND threatened me saying I got custody of you. AND you do AS I say or you

I Ate ALL I could make + April were laughing at me. I split 2 on purpose AND helped me eat them. I hate BANANA splits to this very day.

Don + Joyce had to go to her moms for A week OR so because of a death in her family. Jean loved that, She immediately went to their house + Broke in TAKING ANYthing + Everything including Joyces nicest clothes. She hid the clothes under her

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old clothes on a hanger in the closet. You could  
see them, the expensive stuff she put in the  
attic of our house. When Dan returned Joyce  
came to the house, I hid from her, I wasn't much  
of a liar. And I loved her & Dan. She seen  
me through the window and I had to let her  
in. I told her the truth, and she said she  
wouldn't tell on me, the kids were asleep so  
I gave her clothes back. Jean never did

Sometimes it would be 11pm before I finished dishes, I sat outside staring at the stars wanting to fly up there.

Jean knew her baby belonged to Ed, & so did I. She took a bunch of pills to get rid of it, she vomited & started bleeding bad. Delmar took her to the hospital. So now I had 3 kids, housework, dishes, ironing & cooking laundry and no help. Don stopped by to tell us Joyce left him, and he helped me out. There was a bad storm coming and a tornado watch. Don stayed with me and

He could see I was about at Witts end  
He told me. Sis I will get you out of  
here somehow. but he didn't. He stayed  
A few days and left.

I turned 15, ready for my 9<sup>th</sup> grade  
and I'd have to go to town 15 miles away  
to go. Jean me drop out, said there was  
no way to get there

Esther just returned to Uoles and  
she came out to see if I could go to  
Uoles for the night & go to the movies
