Curlew changes spring break

CURLEW — Spring break in the Curlew School District was changed last week to March 17-23 to give school officials time to work on plans for services during the state-mandate school closure.

The school board took action March 14 during an emergency

meeting.

Meal services, consisting of a lunch bag containing both breakfast and lunch, were available as of March 18. On Monday, March 23, the district began delivering meals twice a week, on Mondays and Thursdays, either by bus or school car to designated locations.

"Please bring something to carry your lunches home in and remember to allow a five-minute leeway for delivery," said the district. "In order to receive the meals, you and your student(s) will need to be at your designated spot at the scheduled time.

On delivery days, stops are planned on Lambert Creek Road, 10:18 a.m.; Malo Store, 10:25 a.m.; Empire Creek, 10:31 a.m.; Lancaster, 10:45 a.m.; Curlew Civic Hall, 10:50 a.m.; Airport Road, 11:10 a.m.; Lone Ranch Creek Road, 11:20 a.m., and Danville Post Office, 11:35 a.m.

Sign-ups and cancellations can be done through the school office or by emailing amykjolseth@curlew.wednet.edu.

The district also will provide

child care for students whose family members/guardians are health care workers and first responders.

Information about student enrichment and educational services will be available

starting today, March 25.
