OMAK — Paschal Sherman Indian School is providing educational packets for its students during the state-imposed school closure.

“No work will be collected back from students until (the) closure period is over,” said an announcement from the school. “We are exploring a plan to provide all students with Internet access for educational games and communications.”

Parents and guardians are asked to contact the

school if they experience hardships because of a lack of child care or income.

“We can report this data to the appropriate agencies for emergency relief information,” said the school.

Paschal Sherman will provide breakfast and lunch, delivered to children’s homes, during the closure. Families are asked to contact the school each Monday to report the number of meals needed for children under age 18.
