Bridgeport offers meal services

BRIDGEPORT — Both graband-go and delivered meal services are available to children up to age 18 in the Bridgeport School District during the state-imposed school closure.

People can pick up bagged breakfast and lunch in the elementary school lunchroom. Breakfast pickup is 7:30-9 a.m. and lunch is 11:30 a.m. to 12:30

"The school district will also deliver meals to those students living out of town and (who) normally ride the school bus," said a district announcement.

Buses will leave the school at 8 a.m. and arrive at bus stops between 8 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. for breakfast. The lunch run is from 11-11:30 a.m.

"If you have children that do not go to school, they are eligible for meals as well," the district said. "Please contact the district to let us know if additional meals need to be prepared and/or delivered on bus routes."

The school office remains open during the closure.

Teachers may issue assignments to be completed at home and turned in periodically. Students who normally ride the bus may turn their assignments in to the bus driver when food is delivered for breakfast or lunch.

"This is primarily for middle school and high school students," said the district.
