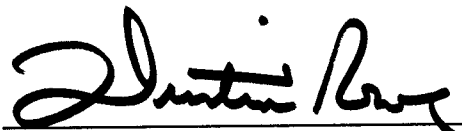

ORDER

Appellee's Motion to Dismiss Appeal as premature for lack of an appealable order is hereby granted. 12 O.S. 2021, §§ 952, 953, 990A. An order prepared in conformance with 12 O.S. 2021, §§ 696.3 and 696.2 is a jurisdictional prerequisite to the commencement of an appeal. *Laubach v. Laubach*, 2022 OK 78, ¶ 7, ___ P.3d ___. A summary order and the like "are not appealable orders which trigger the time to appeal." *Id.* at ¶ 5.

Appellant will have 30 days from the date of the filing of an order in appealable form, or 30 days from the date of this Order, whichever date is later, within which to commence a new appeal. 12 O.S. 2021, § 990A(F) and Rule 1.26(c), *Oklahoma Supreme Court Rules*, Tit. 12, ch. 15, App. 1.
