Dear Senator Biaggi:

Thank for taking the time to meet with Village Manager John T. Pierpont and me recently to discuss needs in the Village of Pelham Manor. Please accept this correspondence as a memorialization of the matters we spoke about at our meeting, as well as Pelham Manor's formal request for funding.

At our in-person meeting, we discussed funding for paving Boston Post Road and funding for solar panels on Pelham Manor Village Hall. Since that time, I have received resident requests for a red light enforcement camera at the intersection of Boston Post Road and Pelhamdale Avenue and a pedestrian crossing signal at the intersection of Boston Post Road and Esplanade. Specifically, we request New York State funding for the following four efforts:

- 1) **Funding to pave Boston Post Road in Pelham Manor (from the Bronx border to the New Rochelle border).** There are large potholes, craters and uneven pavement, creating hazardous driving conditions. This is a highly trafficked New York State Department of Transportation maintained road.
- 2) **Funding for solar panels on Pelham Manor Village Hall.** Our roof is oriented well for sun exposure, and this would be part of our green initiatives.

- 3) **Funding for a red light enforcement camera at the intersection of Boston Post Road and Pelhamdale Avenue.** This is a key intersection in our Village, known as Four Corners, and children cross here regularly while walking to and from school (walking school district). Residents have reported that cars run red lights at this intersection. In response, the Village has deployed police resources for traffic enforcement and pedestrian education, but the violations continue.

- 4) **Funding for a pedestrian crossing signal at the intersection of Boston Post Road and Esplanade.** This would promote pedestrian safety, as this is also a busy intersection on Boston Post Road.

Thank you for your time and for your attention to these important matters. We look forward to working with you.
