PUBLIC QUESTIONS TO BE SUBMITTED TO VOTERS

The text of public questions submitted to voters, if applicable, are as follows:

Oak Hill United School Corporation Operating Referendum

Shall Oak Hill United School Corporation increase property taxes paid to the School Corporation for no more than eight (8) years for the purpose of funding and sustaining educational and operational stability in response to reductions in property tax revenue, including maintaining essential health and safety initiatives including the employment and retention of school resource officers and nurses, supporting, attracting and retaining teachers and staff, maintaining class sizes and student transportation, and funding academic and support programs to meet the educational needs of all students, by imposing a property tax rate that does not exceed \$0.3332 and results in a maximum annual amount that does not exceed \$1,627,112? If this operating referendum public question is approved by the voters, for a median residence of \$150,000, the property's annual property tax bill would increase by \$198 per year.

Public Question #1

Currently, under the Constitution of the State of Indiana, a person charged with murder or treason is not entitled to be released on bail if the proof is evident or the presumption strong. Shall the Constitution of the State of Indiana be amended to provide that a person charged with an offense other than murder or treason is not entitled to bail if:

- (1) the proof is evident or the presumption strong; and
- (2) the state proves by clear and convincing evidence that no release conditions will reasonably protect the safety of any other person or the community.

This question concerns Article 1, Section 17 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.)

Public Question #2

Shall the Constitution of the State of Indiana be amended to permit the judge of a city or town court to reside in: (1) the county in which the court is located; or (2) the bordering county closest to the city or town in which the court is located? (This question concerns Article 6, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.)
