

Defendants in Two Cases Commit- ted to County Jail

Samuel Smalls and Frank Brown, defendants in two cases referred from police court to Magistrate Brown Monday morning, were committed to the county jail in default of bond.

Smalls, who is a cripple and is familiar to King street pedestrians with his goat and cart, was held for the June term of the court of session on an aggravated assault charge. It is alleged that on Saturday night he attempted to shoot Maggie Barnes at No. 4 Romney street. His shots went wide of the mark. Smalls was up on a similar charge some months ago and was given a suspended sentence.

Frank Brown is charged with attempting to shoot Policeman Maree on Charles street Sunday night. The officer alleges that Brown drew a 45-caliber pistol on him and threatened to pull the trigger. Officer Maree, however, managed to arrest him without a shot being fired. Brown is also accused of having a loaded weapon. At the request of the defendant's attorney the hearing was continued until Tuesday. In default of \$300 bond he is being held in jail.
