DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE

**Assault & Battery, Second Degree
16-03-600(D)**

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based upon the following facts:

That on or about November 30, 2020, while employed as a Corrections Officer at the Sheriff Al Cannon Detention Center, located in the City of North Charleston, County of Charleston, State of South Carolina, the aforesaid, Aaron Turner Renaud, did commit the offense of **Assault & Battery, second degree**, a violation of section 16-3-600(D), of the South Carolina Code of Laws of 1976, as amended. In that he did willfully, unlawfully and feloniously threw the juvenile victim against the wall, railing, and floor of the elevator, while the victim was handcuffed and unable to brace or adequately protect himself, causing injury to the victim.


