I held out hope that the GCLS Executive Director and/or the board chair would issue a statement correcting the record about the dismantling and reinstallation of PRIDE displays in the GCLS on June 22nd. Since a statement is apparently not forthcoming, here is mine:

1. The board did not make a decision to remove PRIDE displays. Attributing the action to the board is a lie.

I was not consulted. I had NO voice in this decision. Who made the decision? Either the Executive Director and/or the board chair. The lack of a response from either the Executive Director or the board chair to correct the misrepresentation that this was a board decision is appalling.

- 2. The silence from the board surrounding the decision to first remove and then reinstall the displays is untenable.
- 3. Real harm has been done to members of our community, especially members within the GCLS. The harm needs to be addressed. The staff need to be supported.
- 4. The board is feckless and dysfunctional. It mostly works well when there is no discord. It crumbles in the face of potential controversy. Greenville County Library system deserves a functioning and responsive board. Board members need meaningful and recurring training.
- 5. I am calling for the Executive Director and the board chair to step down. We need new leadership that is responsive and courageous in the face of hatred and bigotry.
- 6. I am calling for the full implementation of measures outlined in "A Joint Statement on the Removal of LGBTQ+ Displays in Greenville County Libraries" signed by Caroline Caldwell, Tyler Prescott and Josh Malkin (attached), including the call to County Council to commit to appointing an LGBTQ+ person to the board of trustees upon the next board seat opening.
- 7. I no longer trust the people I am supposed to work with. I will not continue to serve on a board that is not doing its job, is not responsive to the entire community, and is not transparent. I resign immediately so an LGBTQ+ person can be appointed.
