Key Performance Indicators

- Unruly student behavior that disrupts the learning environment is addressed consistently and fairly.
- Student hearings are conducted by District Hearing Officers for students who have violated established codes of conduct and appropriate punishments are assigned. (See graphs for HCS's hearings, expulsions, and appeals to the District and to the School Board.)
- Meetings and trainings were held with school district administrators to discuss discipline issues, concerns, and procedures.
- Appeal Board training and reviews were held as necessary for District Appeal Board members to review procedures, district policies, and law.
- The District maintains a successful alternative program.
- The District has agreements with an outside agency to provide programs on tobacco, alcohol, and drug abuse prevention for our students.

Year-over-Year Trends

- There is always a change in school disciplinary infractions when there is new administration.

Significant Accomplishments

- Overall, HCS saw a decrease in disciplinary infractions and evidentiary hearings.

New Initiatives or Significant Changes

- HCS continues to see a high volume of students using vapes that contain THC. HCS has developed a vape taskforce that will explore resources that will, hopefully, reduce the number of disciplinary infractions.

Areas Requiring Attention

- Provide support to all new administrators.

Planned Next Steps

- Student Affairs will continue to work with administrators through the following methods: weekly reminders and updates, professional development opportunities, state department roundtables, one-on-one training and data analysis.

All levels exclude tardies in behavior count.

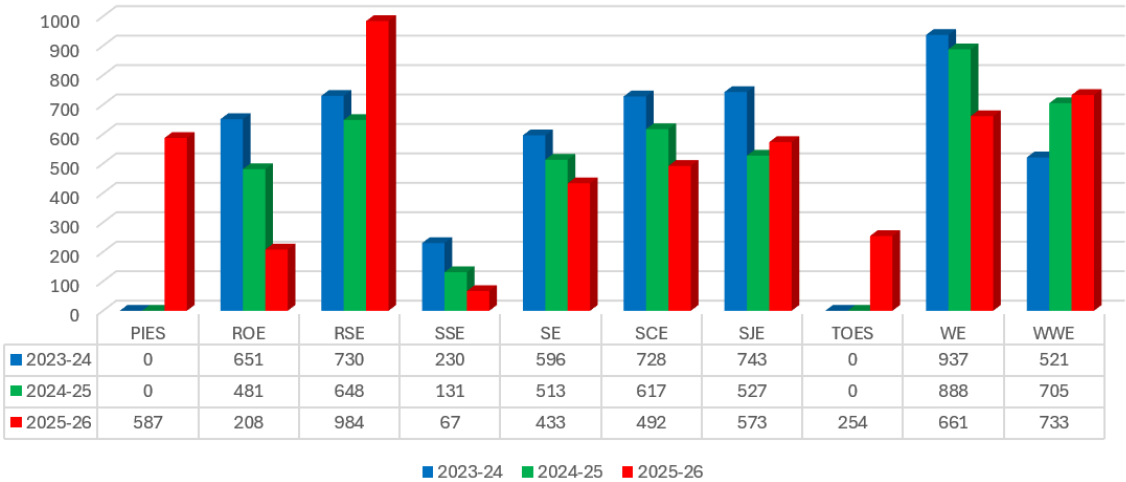

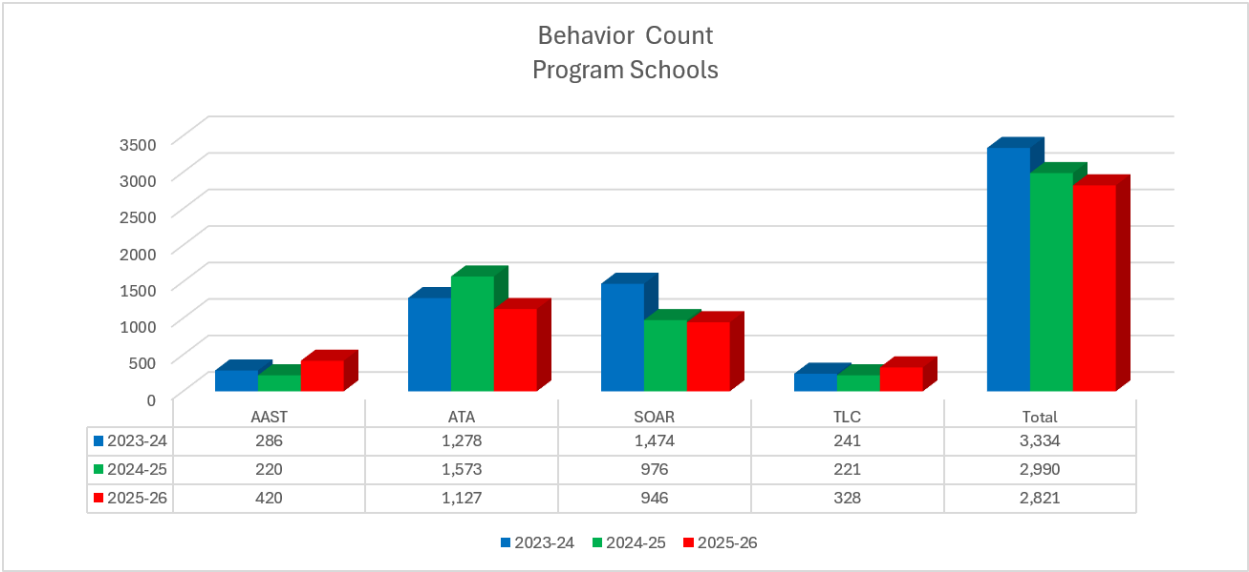
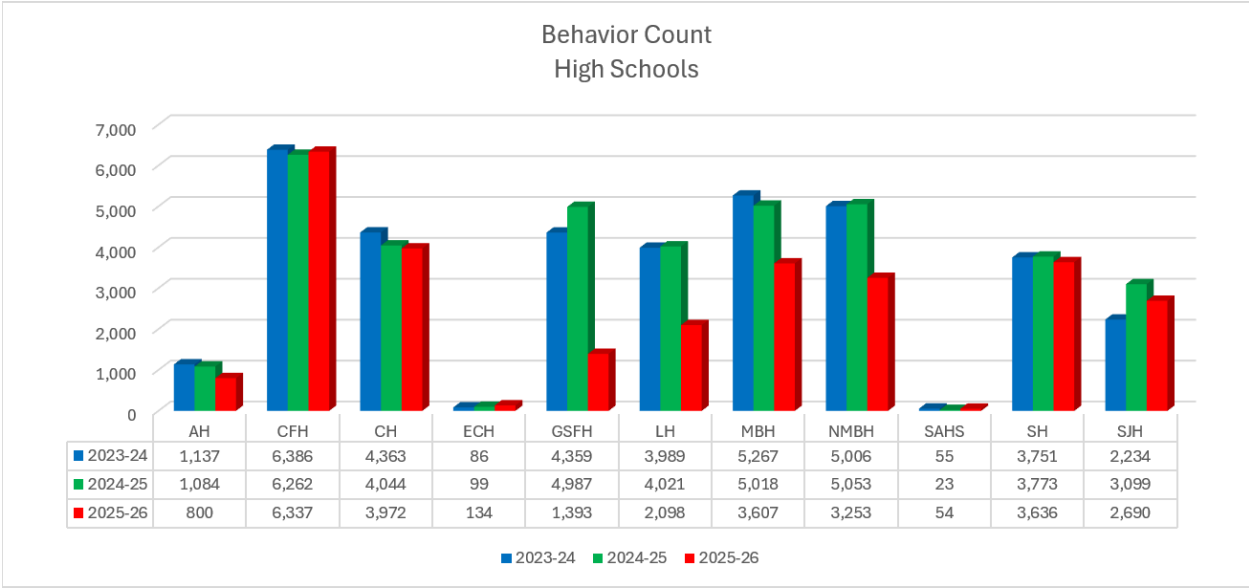
Behavior Count

Middle Schools



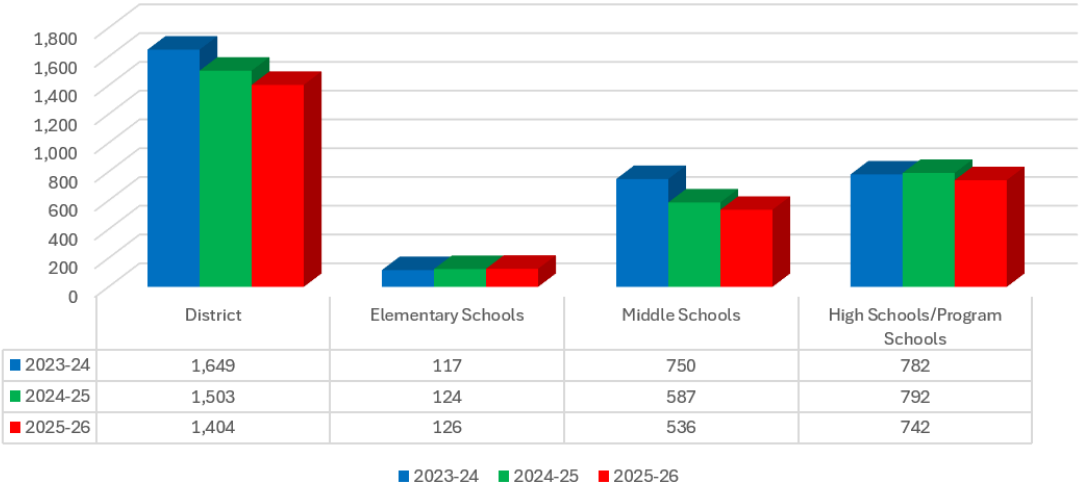

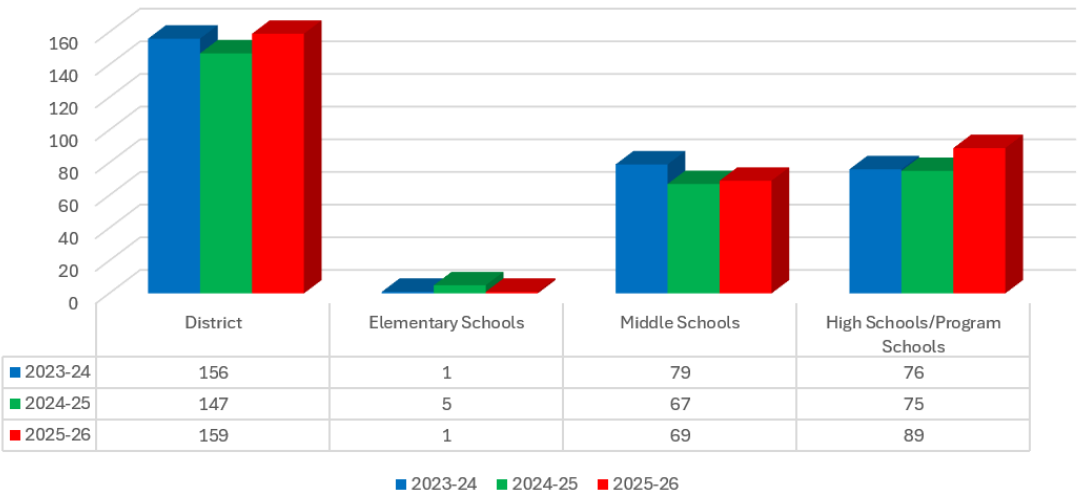
