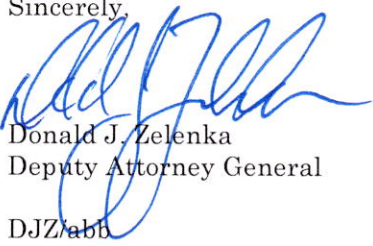
Dear Solicitor Richardson:
