SLED CHARGES FORMER SUMMERVILLE POLICE OFFICER WITH MURDER

Today the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) charged Anthony DeLustro with Murder.

Details can be found in the attached warrant.

On Wednesday, March 20, 2024, Anthony DeLustro, 64, a Summerville Police Department officer who was off-duty, and Michael O'Neal, 39, engaged in an altercation at a Chick-fil-A located at 1312 North Main Street in Summerville, SC. O'Neal was shot by DeLustro and died at the scene.

SLED's investigation is active and ongoing.

DeLustro was booked at the Berkeley County Detention Center.

The case will be prosecuted by the 9th Circuit Solicitor's Office.

AFFIDAVIT SLED CASE# 31-24-0040

Personally appeared before me, a Magistrate of BERKELEY County, one SENIOR SPECIAL AGENT RYAN KELLY who first being duly sworn, deposes and says that

ANTHONY DELUSTRO DOB: 1959

Did within this County and State on or about MARCH 20, 2024, violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE MURDER

VIOLATION OF SECTION 16-3-10

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based upon the following facts:

That on MARCH 20, 2024, while in the parking lot of Chick fil A located at 1312 North Main Street, Summerville, SC, located in the County of Berkeley, State of South Carolina, one ANTHONY DELUSTRO, did commit the offense of MURDER, in violation of section 16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws of 1976, as amended.

At the time ANTHONY DELUSTRO was an off-duty police officer employed by the Summerville Police Department. A confrontation occurred between ANTHONY DELUSTRO and the victim, Michael O' Neal, where ANTHONY DELUSTRO exited his vehicle and an altercation ensued between the two. Eyewitnesses described ANTHONY DELUSTRO as the primary aggressor in the altercation. According to an eyewitness, after exiting their vehicles, the victim asked ANTHONY DELUSTRO, "Do you want to do this?" several times. The eyewitness heard ANTHONY DELUSTRO respond, "Come on you fucking faggot." Punches and kicks were exchanged between ANTHONY DELUSTRO and the victim. Bystanders attempted to separate the two as they continued to exchange blows. At some point during the scuffle, ANTHONY DELUSTRO told the victim he was under arrest. ANTHONY DELUSTRO also removed his Summerville Police Department law enforcement credentials from the back pocket of his pants and briefly presented them before they fell to the ground during the struggle. During the fight, ANTHONY DELUSTRO'S Springfield Armory XD handgun fell from ANTHONY DELUSTRO's holster onto the pavement, coming to rest behind DELUSTRO's white Ford Edge.

As the fight continued, the victim disengaged, and an eyewitness heard the victim say he wanted to leave. Evidence showed that the victim then disengaged and retreated from the physical altercation with ANTHONY DELUSTRO and returned to his vehicle, a Hyundai Genesis, in an attempt to leave. An eyewitness, while restraining ANTHONY DELUSTRO, heard DELUSTRO tell the victim he (DELUSTRO) would shoot the victim if he left. ANTHONY DELUSTRO broke free from the bystander(s) holding him, ran to the rear of his vehicle, and picked up his Springfield Armory XD handgun from the pavement. ANTHONY DELUSTRO then reengaged the victim by approaching the Hyundai Genesis armed with his handgun. ANTHONY DELUSTRO's wife attempted to physically restrain the victim during the altercation, and later when the victim attempted to get in his vehicle to leave.

ANTHONY DELUSTRO then opened the passenger side door of the Hyundai Genesis and entered the vehicle while armed with his handgun. The victim, Michael O'Neal, shouted for ANTHONY DELUSTRO to "get out of my car."

As the victim began to drive away, ANTHONY DELUSTRO, while still partially seated in the passenger seat of the victim's vehicle, fired a single shot from his handgun. The victim, Michael O'Neal, was shot and killed at the scene.

In an interview with law enforcement, ANTHONY DELUSTRO acknowledged that he knew the victim was attempting to leave the area and it was DELUSTRO'S intent to stop him. ANTHONY DELUSTRO acknowledged that he never saw the victim with a firearm or any other weapon, and that the victim never threatened the use of any sort of weapon. ANTHONY DELUSTRO claimed to law enforcement that after the physical altercation between ANTHONY DELUSTRO and the victim had ended, he (DELUSTRO) approached the victim's vehicle with his handgun and entered the victim's vehicle in an attempt to prevent the victim from leaving.

Eyewitness accounts, video evidence and ANTHONY DELUSTRO's statement to law enforcement show that the victim, Michael O'Neal, retreated from the altercation before ANTHONY DELUSTRO confronted him with a firearm. A reasonable person could not have reasonably believed that the victim posed a threat of imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury to others because the victim was unarmed, walked away from the altercation and attempted to leave in his vehicle.

Eyewitness accounts and video evidence show that ANTHONY DELUSTRO reengaged the victim when he approached the victim's vehicle after the initial altercation had ended. Eyewitness accounts, video evidence and ANTHONY DELUSTRO's statement to law enforcement show ANTHONY DELUSTRO recklessly put himself in danger when he entered the victim's vehicle armed with a handgun. While ANTHONY DELUSTRO's claims do not meet the elements of self-defense, the eyewitness testimony, the statement of ANTHONY DELUSTRO and the video evidence show that victim Michael O'Neal did have a right to act in self-defense.

ANTHONY DELUSTRO claimed he used deadly force as the victim drove away because the victim refused to stop his vehicle and ANTHONY DELUSTRO believed he could not get his legs out from beneath moving the vehicle. Eyewitness accounts and video evidence do not corroborate the claims that ANTHONY DELUSTRO made after the incident that he was in fear for the community's safety and for his wife's safety.

In that the defendant ANTHONY DELUSTRO was in possession of a firearm and did kill the victim with malice aforethought, in that ANTHONY DELUSTRO shot and murdered the victim, Michael O'Neal.

The above information is true and accurate and was obtained through witness statements, videos and the investigation of the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division.
