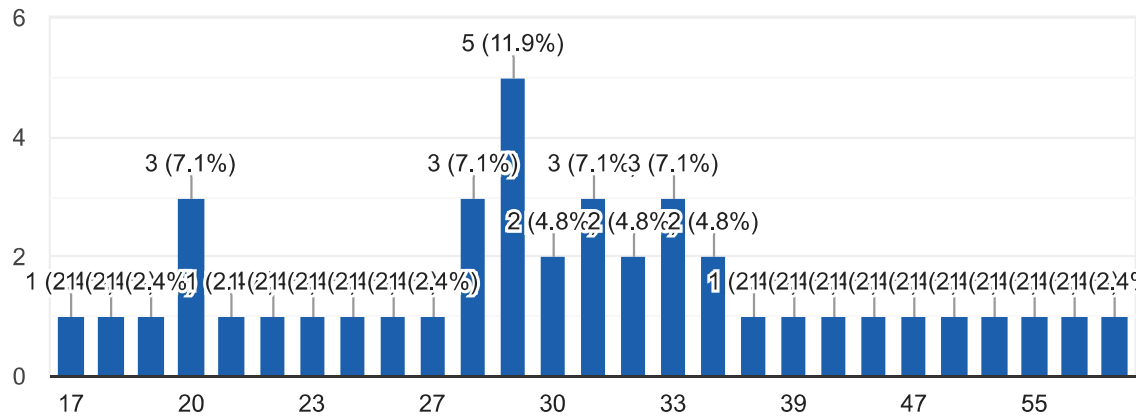

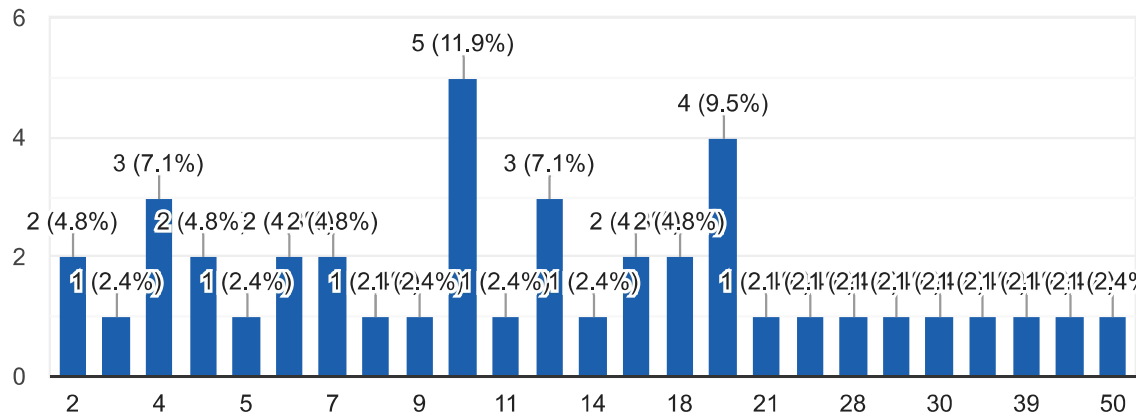

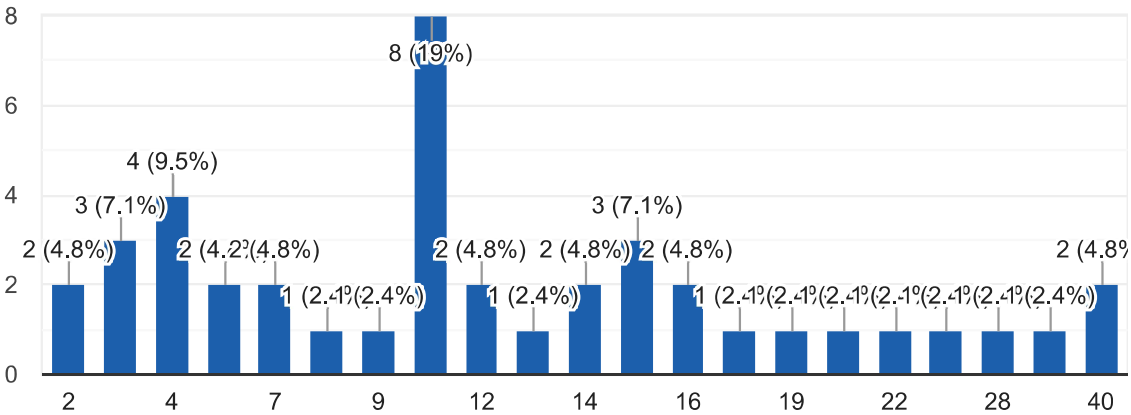

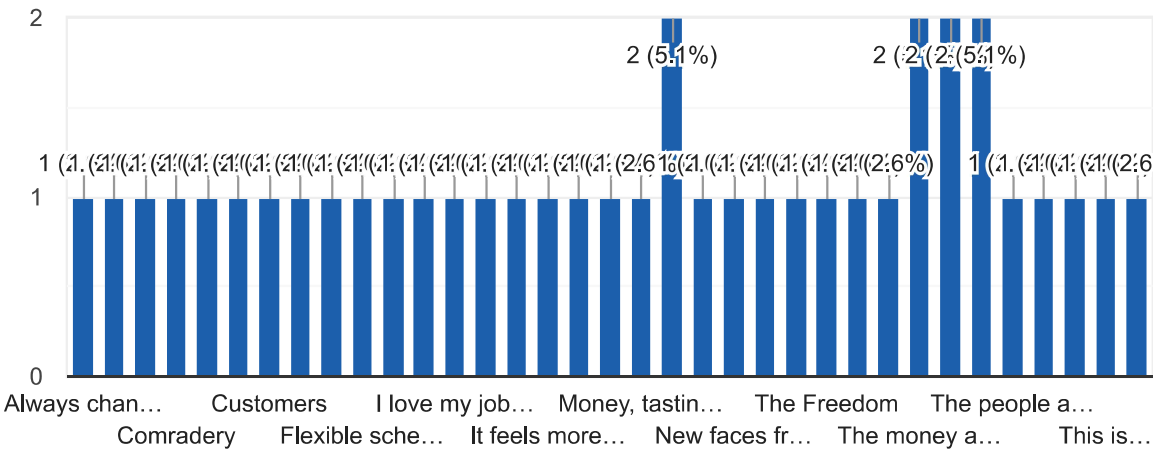

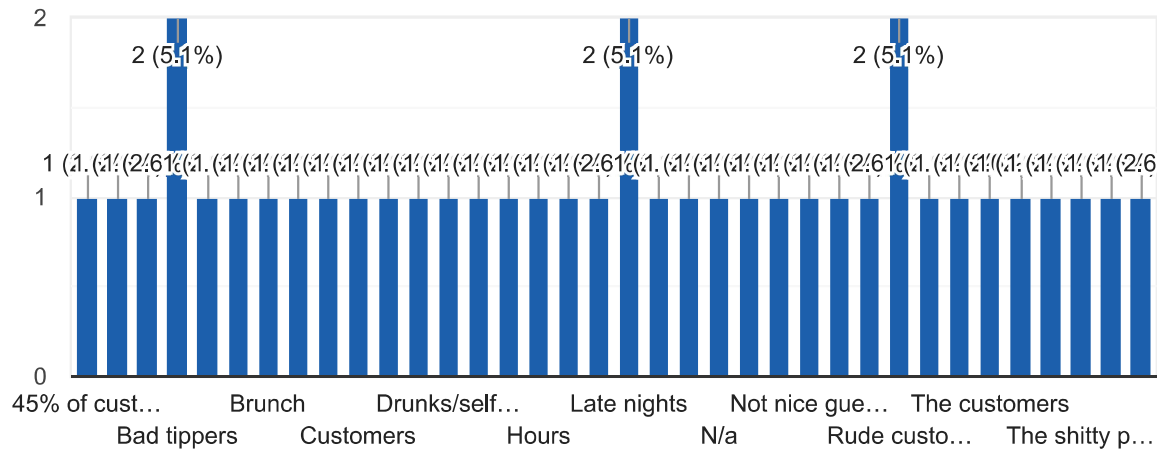

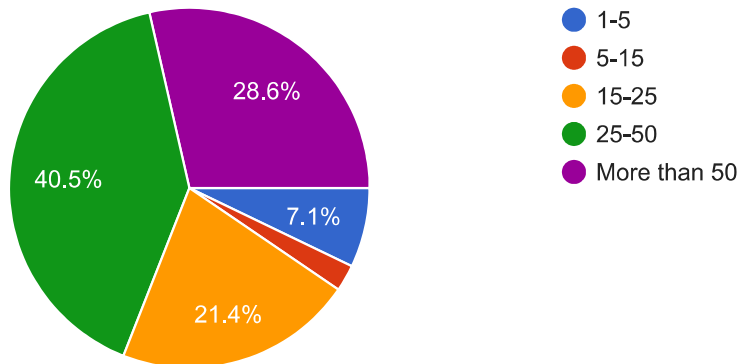

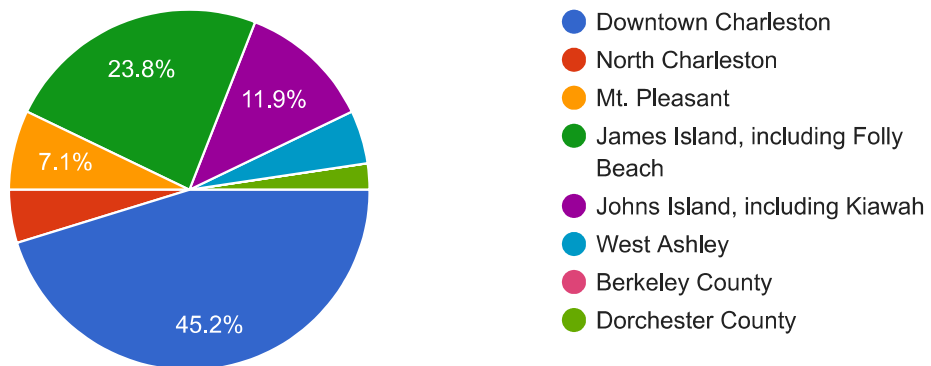

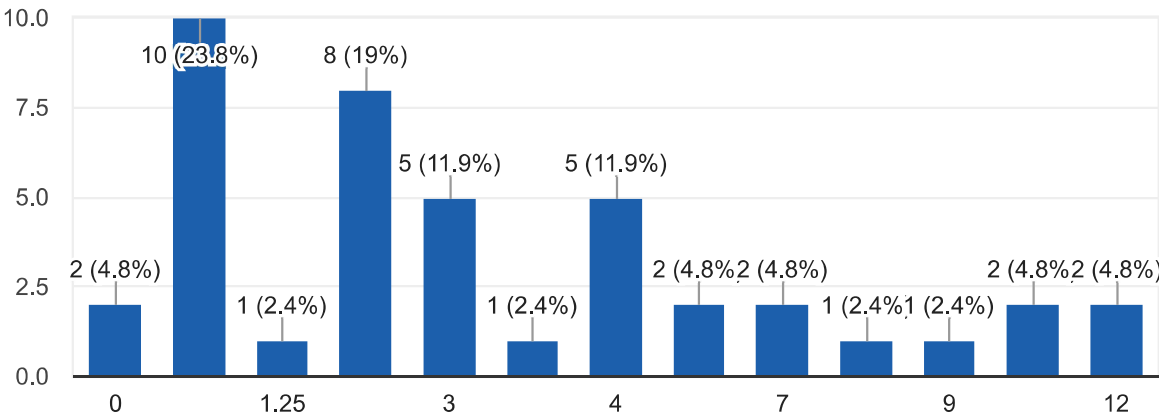

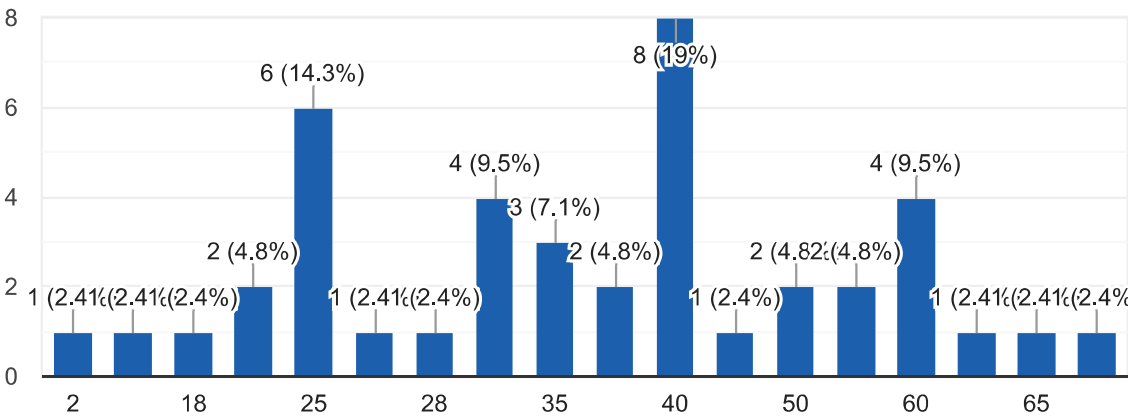

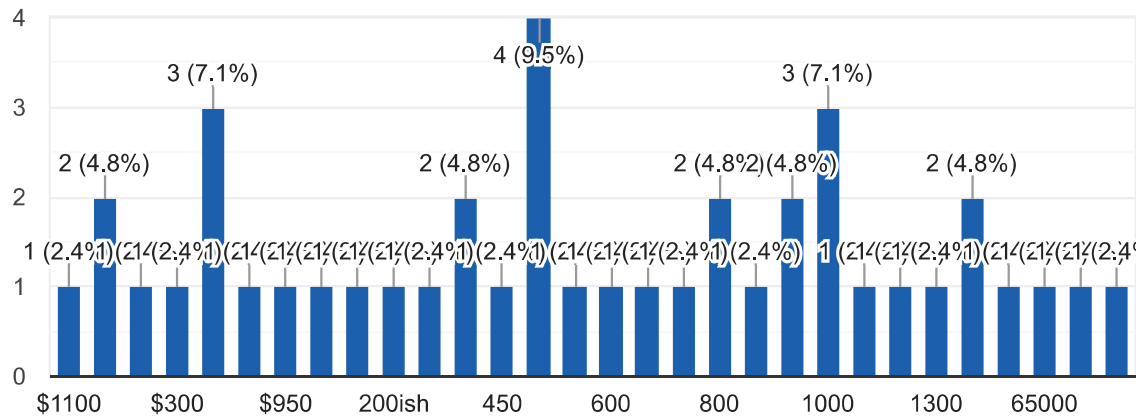

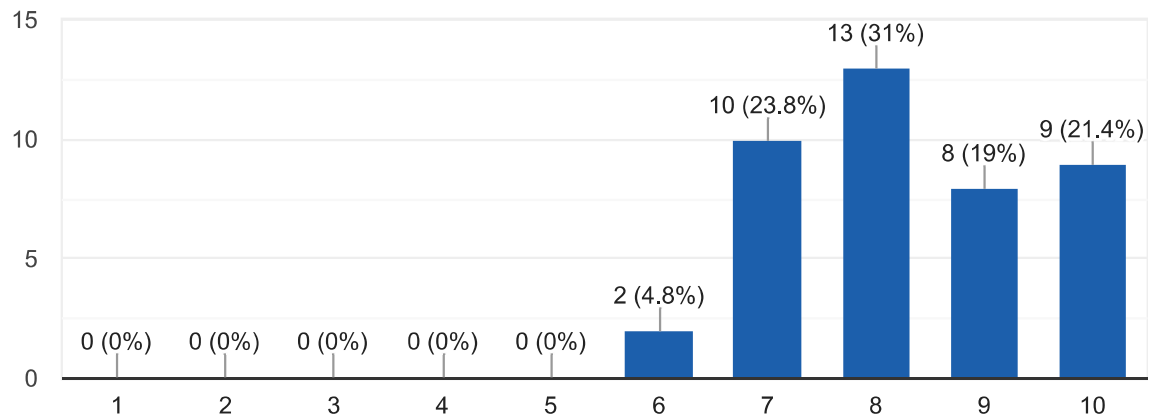

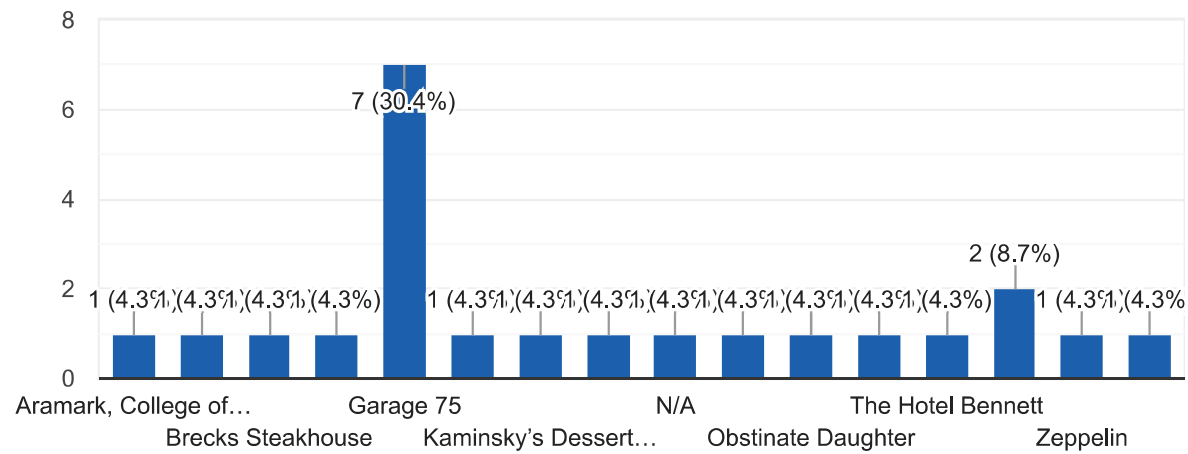

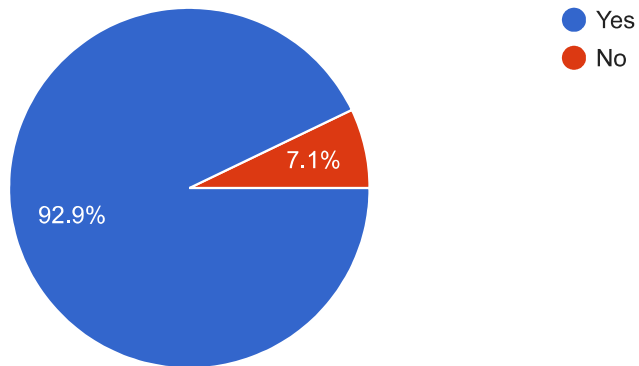

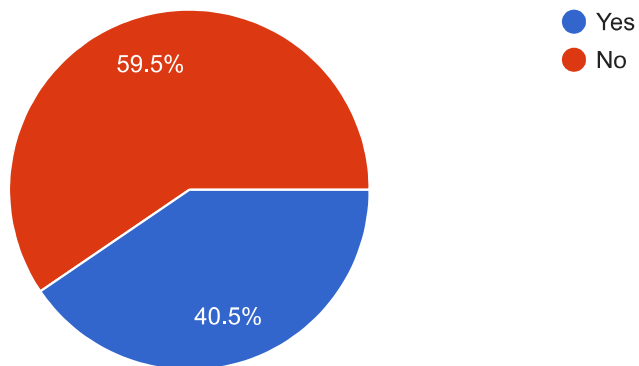

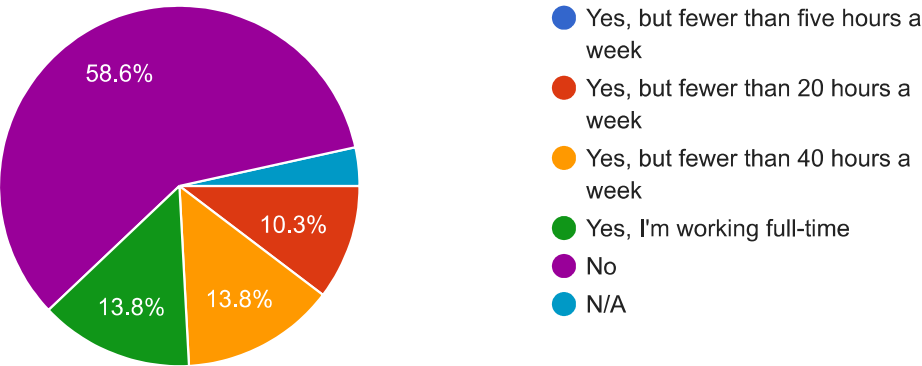

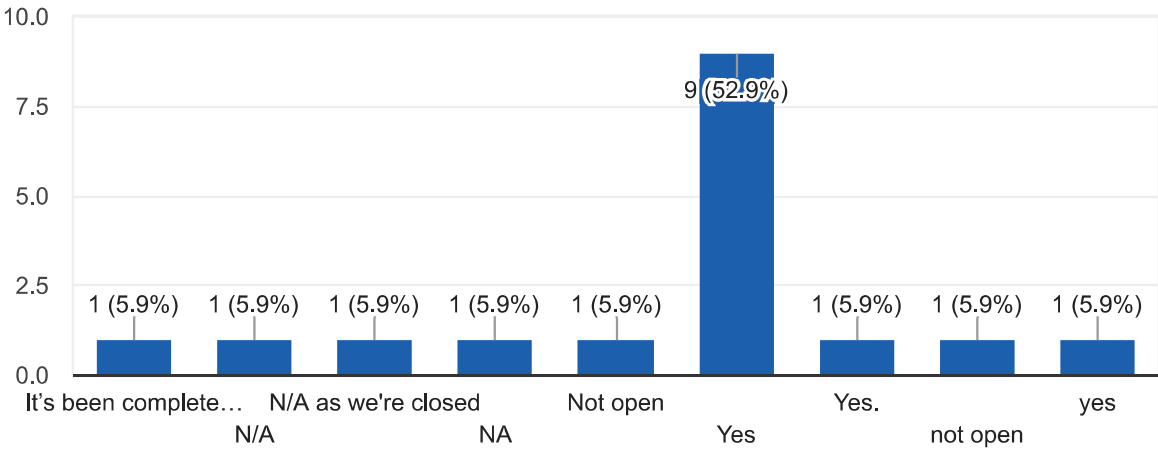

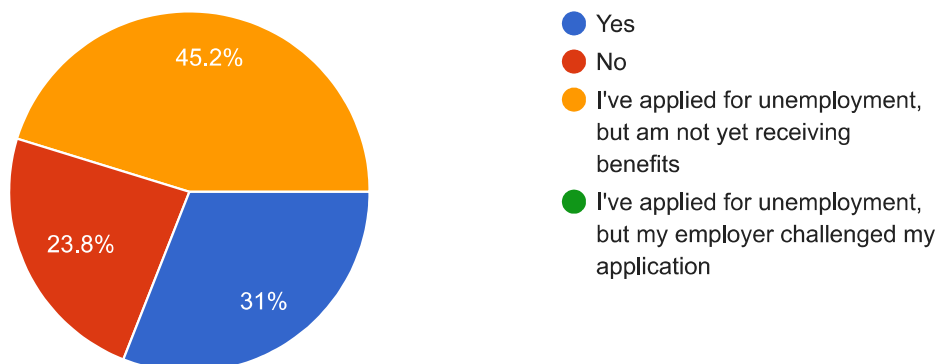

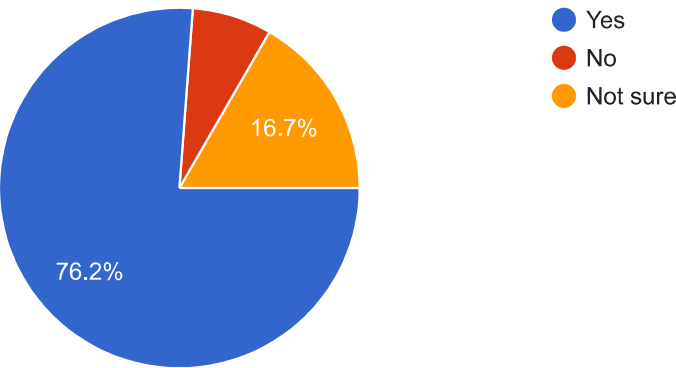

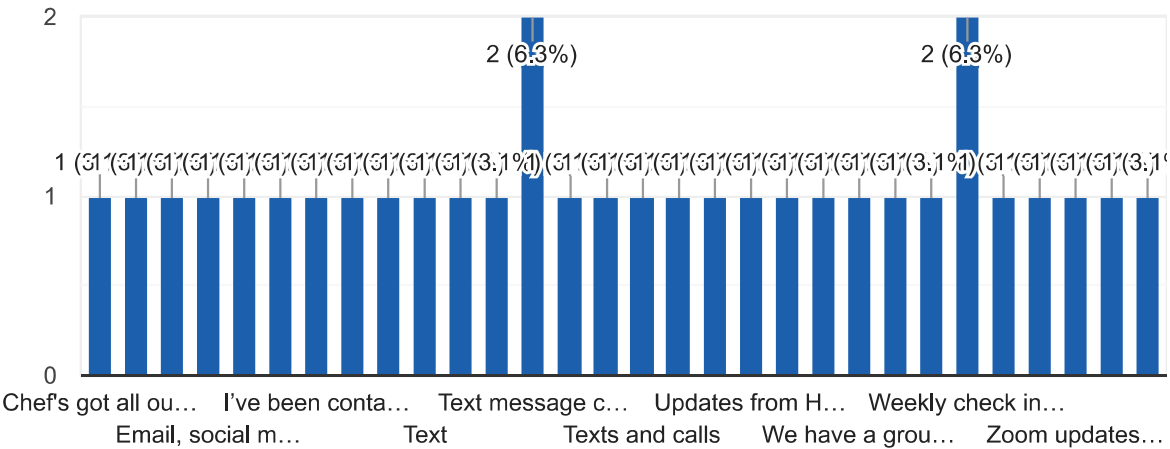

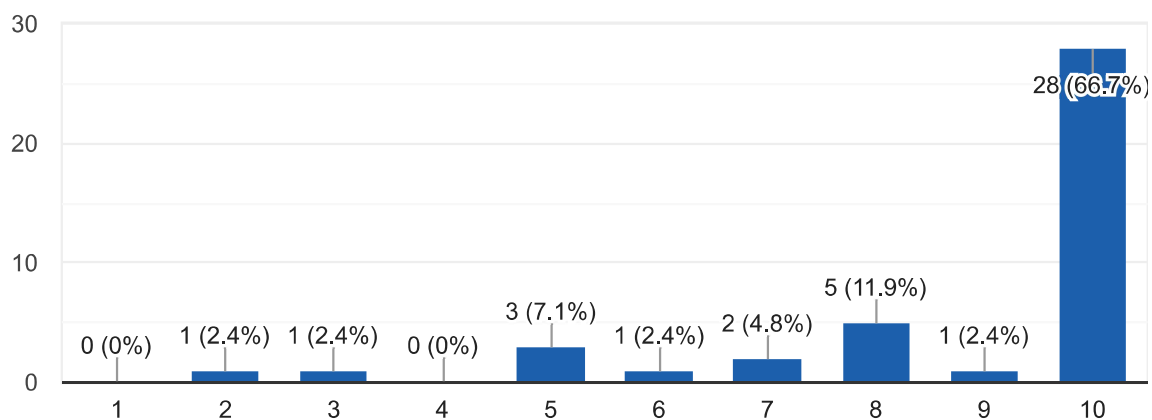

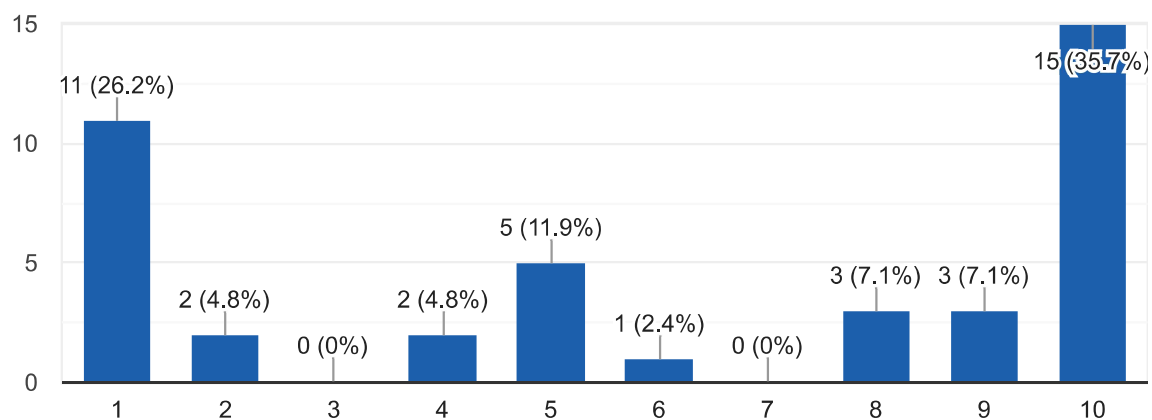
How likely are you to keep working for your current or most recent employer at your previous rate of pay?

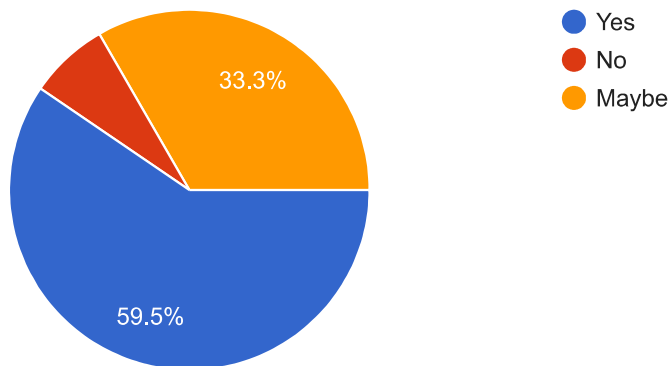
How likely are you to keep working for your current or most recent employer at a higher rate of pay?
