On 09/02/06 the victim gave a written statement to Detective Magwood stating that as she was walking from a friends house she was approached by a black male only known by the street name at " Poochie" . This subject came up behind her and grabbed her from behind by the back of the neck and dragged her behind a vacant building, possibly a Barber Shop. He then proceeded to force her clothes off and physically forcing his penis into her vagina. He also while raping her took a beer bottle and broke it then held it to her throat. The beer bottle was tested negative for prints and no other evidence was located at the time. The victim described the suspect As being approximately 5'6", 170 to 175lb, Black/ Brown, wearing a black pant and dark boxer shorts he appeared to be 20 to 25 yoa.

On 09/08/06 this I/D received a phone call from the victim and the complainant, who stated that they saw the suspect walking pass her residence. He is known by the name of " Poochie" on the street, but they do not know his real name. They will attempt to get his real name and call this I/D back with the information.

On 10/03/06 this I/D telephoned the victim and spoke to her son, he will have the victim contact this I/D when she returns home.

This I/D again stoke to the victim on 10/13/06, she at that time refused to talk about the possible suspect or give any other information on the incident.

On October 23, 2007 this I/D received a SLED report on the DNA evidence recovered from the victim. The report indicated that the listed suspect, Maurice Jerome Prioleau,s seamen was found in the victim,

This I/D located the victim and showed her a photo lineup that contained a photo of the listed suspect and five other individuals. The victim picked out the suspect and positively identified him as being her assailant.

The listed suspect was apprehended and transported to the Charleston County Detention where he was lodged pending a hearing.

On 11/13/07 this I/D interviewed the suspect, Maurice Jerome Piroleau, he gave a written statement after he was advised of his Miranda rights and signing a written waiver waiving same. He stated that he met the victim while walking home from a club. they got together they went behind an abandoned building where they had consensual sexual intercourse. The victim got \$50.00 in Crack Cocaine for the sex, because that's what she wanted. After she had smoked up all of the cocaine she got upset and wanted more Crack Cocaine. This was when she was left at that location.

Case closed with one arrest and two warrant served
